# Sunset Stripes Shawl



**TYPE:** Knit

**DESIGNER:** Tori Gurbisz for Premier® Yarns

## SIZE

One Size

## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

**Wingspan:** 60"

**Depth:** 17½"

## GAUGE:

24 sts x 42 rows = 4" in Garter st

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## MATERIALS:

[Premier® Yarns Sock Kit \(50% Superwash Merino Wool, 25% Bamboo, 25% Polyamide; 1 - .88oz/25g, 114yds/105m and 2 - 1.75oz/50g, 229yds/210m\)](#)

## NEEDLES & NOTIONS:

- [US Size 6 \(4 mm\) 24" circular needle or size needed to obtain gauge](#)
- [Tapestry needle, stitch markers,](#)



## SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Knit sts.
- Changing colors.
- Yarn over increases.

## PATTERN NOTES

This beginner Shawl is worked flat from the center outward.

## SHAWL

*Note: CC is the single small solid ball and MC is the 2 larger multi balls in each kit.*

### SETUP

With MC cast on 3 sts, pm, cast on 3 sts.

### MAIN BODY

**Row 1:** K1, [k1, yo, k1] in next st, knit to m, yo, sm, knit to end – 2 sts inc'd.  
Rep Row 1 for patt, until 1 ball of MC has been used.

Join CC and second ball of MC, cont working Row 1, following this stripe sequence:

2 rows CC

4 rows MC

Rep this sequence until there is not enough CC left to complete a stripe.

Work 4 more rows in MC, or until there is approximately 20-30 yards (10-15 gm) remaining, piece will meas approximately 17½” along center spine, from cast-on.

Loosely bind off all sts.

## FINISHING

Wash and block, if desired.

Weave in ends.

<b>yo</b>	yarn over
