

Diamond Tapestry Throw

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 39¼" Length: 42½"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns *Serenity® Chunky* (100% Acrylic; 3.5 oz/100g, 109 yds/100m)

• MC: 700-63 Blue Bird – 7 balls

Premier® Yarns Canyon Colors™ (100% Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 109yds/100m)

• CC: 2098-07 Summer Breeze – 7 balls **Hook:** US Size K-10½ (6.5 mm) *or size needed to*

obtain gauge

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

10 sc x 12 rnds = 4" with a single strand 10 sc x 10 rows = 4" in tapestry crochet Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain and single crochet stitches.
- Tapestry crochet.
- Changing colors.
- Working flat and in the round.

PATTERN NOTES

Throw is worked flat in rows. The Border is worked in rounds. Colors are changed using the tapestry method. Hold both colors together throughout each row. Crochet over the color not being used. When switching from one color to another, work the last pull through with the new color.

THROW

With MC, ch 89.

Row 1: Sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch

across, turn – 88 sc.

Join CC and work Rows 1-16 of chart, 6 times. Ch 1 at beg of each row and turn at end of each row. Change colors using the tapestry method. Last Row: Break CC, continue with MC, sc across to last st, 3 sc in last st. Do not turn or

fasten off.

FINISHING

Border

Rnd 1: Now working along row ends, sc in each row end along side edge, 3 sc in lower corner, sc in each sc along opposite side of foundation ch, 3 sc in next lower corner, sc in each row end along next side edge, 3 sc in last corner, join with a sl st to beg sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, working 3 sc in each corner, join with a sl st to beg sc.

Rnds 3-6: Rep Rnd 2.

Fasten off, weave in ends.

CC contrast color

sl st(s) slip stitch(es)
