



RADIANT WAVES THROW

Skill Level: **EASY**

Pattern: **M24181 FR**



LION BRAND® FERRIS WHEEL® RADIANT WAVES THROW

EASY

SIZE

About 39 x 45 in. (99 x 114.5 cm)

MATERIALS

- LION BRAND® FERRIS WHEEL® (Art. #217)
#611 Pink Marmalade 3 cakes (A)
#610 Cherry on Top 2 cakes (B)
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

ADDITIONAL MATERIALS

Crochet hook size H-8 (5 mm)

GAUGE

1 ripple = about 3 1/4 in. (8.5 cm) measured from peak to peak.

BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.

STITCH EXPLANATION

dc2tog (dc 2 sts together) (Yarn over, insert hook in next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 2 loops) twice, yarn over and draw through all 3 loops on hook – 1 st decreased.

NOTES

1. Throw is worked in one piece in a ripple crochet pattern. The ripple pattern is easy to do, but it's important to remember that you may need to work several rows before the ripple pattern becomes clear.
2. The ripple pattern consists of alternating (2 dc in each of 2 sts) peaks and (dc2tog) twice valleys. Take care to keep the peaks and valleys of each row aligned.
3. Yarn color is changed by alternating between 1 cake of A-colored yarn and 1 cake of B-colored yarn. To change to a new cake of yarn, work until almost all yarn of current cake has been used, work last st of old cake to last yarn over. Yarn over with new cake and draw through all loops on hook to complete st. Proceed with new cake.

THROW

With A, ch 171.

Row 1: Dc in 4th ch from hook (3 skipped ch count as dc), dc in next 3 ch, (dc2tog) twice, * dc in next 3 ch, 2 dc in each of next 2 ch, dc in next 3 ch, (dc2tog) twice; rep from * to last 4 ch, dc in next 3 ch, 2 dc in last ch - you will have 14 ripples in this row.

Row 2: Ch 3 (counts as dc), turn, working in back loops only, dc in first st, dc in next 3 sts, (dc2tog) twice, * dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in each of next 2 sts, dc in next 3 sts, (dc2tog) twice; rep from * to last 4 sts, dc in next 3 sts, 2 dc in top of beginning ch.

Rep Row 2 until almost all of the yarn in the current cake has been used, then change to a B-colored cake of yarn and work until almost all of that cake has been used.

Continue in this way, changing to the next cake of A- color yarn, the last cake of B-color yarn and finally to the last cake of A-color yarn. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Weave in ends.
