FREE CROCHET PATTERN

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TYPE: Crochet

DESIGNER: Amy Gunderson for Premier Yarns®

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Width: 33"

Height: 48½"

GAUGE:

Motif = 7¾"

Save time, check your gauge.

MATERIALS:

Premier® Yarns Puzzle® (100% Acrylic; 7oz/200g, 328yds/300m)

- MC: 1050-23 Solitaire - 3 balls

Premier® Yarns Puzzle® Solids (100% Acrylic; 7oz/200g, 328yds/300m)

- CC: 2162-01 Burgundy - 1 balls

HOOKS & NOTIONS:

- US Size I-9 (5.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Chains, slip, and double crochet stitches.
- Magic ring.
- Changing colors.
- Seaming with mattress stitch.
- Working flat and in the round.

STITCH GUIDE

Magic Ring: Wrap yarn around your left finger twice, leaving a 6” tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a loop. Ch 1 and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

PATTERN NOTES

Motifs in this Throw are worked separately and seamed together. Puzzle® Solids and Puzzle® pair together perfectly in this project, and countless others!

THROW

Motif (*make 24*)

With MC, begin with **Magic Ring**.

Rnd 1: Ch 6 (counts as dc + ch 3 here and throughout), [3 dc in ring, ch 3] 3 times, 2 dc in ring, join with sl st to 3rd ch of beg ch-6.

Rnd 2: Sl st in next sp, ch 6, 3 dc in same sp, {ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in next sp} 3 times, ch 1, 2 dc in same sp as beg dc, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3.

Row 3 (RS): Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same sp, ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 sp, ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp, ch 1, 2 dc in last sp, turn.

Row 4 (WS): Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), [3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] 2 times, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 2 times, ch 1, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 5: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 2 times, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 2 times, ch 1, 2 dc in last sp, turn.

Row 6: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), [3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] 3 times, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 3 times, ch 1, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 7: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 3 times, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 3 times, ch 1, 2 dc in last sp, turn.

Row 8: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), [3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] 4 times, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 4 times, ch 1, dc in last dc, turn.

Row 9: Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 4 times, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 4 times, ch 1, 2 dc in last sp, turn.

Row 10: Ch 4 (counts as dc + ch 1), [3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1] 5 times, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in ch-3 sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 5 times, ch 1, dc in last dc, turn. Fasten off.

Join CC with sl st to ch-3 corner sp from Row 10.

Rnd 11: Ch 3 (counts as dc) 2 dc in same sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] 5 times,

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THROW - ROUND 11 CONT.

ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in side of Row 10 around dc; *working along side of piece, [sk next row, ch 1, 3 dc in side of next row] 5 times, ch 1, [3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in corner; rep from * 1 more time, [ch 1, 3 dc in ch-1 sp] along other side of Row 10, ch 1, 3 dc in same sp as beg dc, ch 2, join with sl st to beg dc. Fasten off.

FINISHING

Arrange Motifs according to diagram. Sew together using mattress st.

BORDER

With RS facing, join CC to any corner with sl st.

Rnd 1: Ch 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in same sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] to next corner, ch 1, *[3 dc, ch 3, 3 dc] in corner sp, [ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp] to next corner, ch 1; rep from * 2 more times, 3 dc in same sp as beg dc, ch 2, join with sl st to beg dc.

Fasten off.

Weave in ends and block lightly.
