



## Sunset Cardi

### SIZES

Small (Medium, Large, 1X, 2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)  
Shown in Small Size

### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Bust Circumference:** 36 (38¾, 45¾, 50¾, 52, 57¼, 8¾, 61¼)" without Collar  
**Length:** 23 (24, 24, 25, 25, 26, 26, 27)"

### MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Spun Colors (65% Acrylic, 35% Fine Merino Superwash; 7oz/200g, 419yds/384m):

- 1110-15 Sunrise – 3 (4, 5, 5, 5, 6, 6, 6) cakes

**Hook:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, locking stitch markers

### GAUGE

3 Sh x 9 rows = 4" in Lace Shells Pattern;  
**Save time, check your gauge.**

### Skills/ techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches.
- Single and double crochet stitches.
- Seaming pieces.
- Working stitches in row ends.

### STITCH GUIDE

**Lace Shells** (multiple of 6 sts + 1 + 1 for foundation ch)

**Setup Row:** Sc in 2nd ch from hook, \*sk 2 ch, Sh in next ch, sk 2 ch, sc in next ch; rep from \* to last ch, sc in last ch, turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 4 (counts as dc, ch 1 throughout), dc in same sp (beginning Sh made), sc in center dc of next Sh, \*Sh in next sc, sc in center dc of next Sh; rep from \* to last sc,

(dc, ch 1, dc) in last sc (ending Sh made), turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 1 (does not count as a st throughout), sc in same st, \*Sh in next sc, sc in center dc of next Sh; rep from \* across, ending with sc in 3rd ch of beg ch-4, turn.  
Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

### Lace Shells in the round (multiple of 6)

**Setup Rnd:** Ch 1, sc in same sp, \*sk 2 sc, Sh in next sc, sk 2 sc\*\*, sc in next sc; rep from \* around, ending last rep at \*\*, join to beg sc with a sl st, turn.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 4, dc in same sp (beginning Sh made), sc in center dc of next Sh, \*Sh in next sc, sc in center dc of next Sh; rep from \* around, (dc, ch 1) in same sp as beg ch-4, join to 3rd ch of beg ch-4 with a sl st, turn.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in same sp, \*Sh in next sc, sc in center dc of next Sh; rep from \* to last sc, Sh in last sc, join to beg sc with a sl st, turn.  
Rep Rnds 1-2 for patt.

**Shell (Sh):** [(dc, ch 1) twice, dc] in indicated st/sp.

**V-stitch (V-st):** (dc, ch 1, dc) in indicated st/sp.

### PATTERN NOTES

The Back of this Cardigan is crocheted from the bottom up. The Right Front is worked seamlessly down from the shoulder and the Left Front is picked up and worked down from the shoulder. The sides are seamed to the armhole openings. Then, the Sleeves are worked in turned rounds directly onto the Body. Finally, the Collar is picked up and worked directly onto the Cardigan. For a closer fit, choose a size 1-3" larger than your full bust measurement, for a looser fit, choose a size



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4-6" larger than your full bust measurement.

## GARMENT

### Back

Ch 92 (104, 110, 122, 128, 140, 146, 158)

Work even in **Lace Shells** until piece meas 23 (24, 24, 25, 25, 26, 26, 27)", end having just worked a Row 2, do NOT fasten off.

### Right Front Panel

Count 6 (6, 8, 9, 9, 10, 10, 10) sc from each outer edge of Back panel and pm.

Work Row 1 of **Lace Shells** to first marked st, leave rem sts unworked for neck and Left Front Panel.

Continuing with Row 2, work even in **Lace Shells** until panel meas 23 (24, 24, 25, 25, 26, 26, 27)", end having just worked a Row 2. Fasten off.

### Left Front Panel

Join yarn with a sl st in next marked st.

Work Row 1 of **Lace Shells** to end.

Continuing with Row 2, work even in **Lace Shells** until panel 23 (24, 24, 25, 25, 26, 26, 27)", end having just worked a Row 2. Fasten off.

Starting at lower edges, sew side seams leaving 6 (6.75, 8, 8.75, 9.25, 10, 10.75, 10.75)" unsewn for Sleeves.

### Sleeves

Join yarn at at underarm with a sl st.

**Setup:** Ch 1, evenly sp 54 (60, 72, 78, 84, 90, 96, 96) sc sts around armhole, join to beg sc with a sl st, turn.

Work even in **Lace Shells** in the round until Sleeve meas 17 (17.5, 18, 18, 17.5, 17, 16.5, 16)" from join. Fasten off.

### Collar

With RS facing, join yarn at lower corner of Left Front Panel with a sl st.

**Setup:** Ch 1, working in a multiple of 3, evenly space sc sts across Left Front Panel, around neck opening and down the Right Front Panel, turn.

**Row 1:** Ch 3 (counts as dc here and throughout), sk next sc, \***V-st** in next sc, sk next 2 sc; rep from \* to last sc, dc in last sc, turn.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, \***V-st** in ch-1 sp of next **V-st**; rep from \* to last st, dc in last st, turn.

**Rows 3-11 (11, 13, 13, 15, 15, 15, 15):** Rep Row 2. Fasten off.

## FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block gently if desired.
