Flower Buds Mosaic Throw

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

Width: 46" Length: 43"

MATERIALS

Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Worsted (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic, 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

C1: 100-69 Deep Teal – 6 balls
 Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Painterly
 (100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic, 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

• C2: 2119-04 Jam Session–7 balls **Hook:** US Size H-8 (5 mm) *or size needed to obtain gauge*

Notions: Tapestry needle

GAUGE

15 sts x 16 rows = 4" in pattern. Save time, check your gauge.

Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain, single and double crochet stitches.
- Single crochet join
- Overlay mosaic crochet technique.
- Working in front and back loops of stitches.

STITCH GUIDE

Back loop only single crochet (sc blo): Single crochet in the back lp only.

Long front loop double crochet (Lng fldc):

Yo, insert hook in free Ip of indicated st 2 rows below, yo and pull up a long Ip, (yo, pull through 2 Ips on hook) 2 times, skip the st on working row.

Join with a Single Crochet (sc join): Place slip knot on hook, insert hook in indicated st, yo

and pull up a lp, yo and pull through both lps on hook.

PATTERN NOTES

This Throw is worked flat, from end to end, using the Overlay Mosaic technique. The colorwork designs are created by working back loop only single crochet stitches in working rows and front loop long double crochet stitches in unworked front loops 2 rows below.

Colors alternate each row. Work all rows with one color and right side facing, you will not turn your work. Leave a 6" length of yarn at the beginning and end of each row in each color. These lengths will become the fringe.

Single crochet stitches are worked in back loops only (blo), except for the first 2 and last 2 stitches of each row. The stitch count will remain the same throughout.

The pattern includes both written and charted instructions. Read the chart from bottom to top, right to left. Each square represents 1 stitch.

THROW

Base

With C2, leaving a 6" length, ch 173.

Setup: Working in back bumps of ch, sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, fasten off C2 – 172 sc.

Row 1: Sc join C1, sc in next st, sc blo across to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, leaving a 6" tail, fasten off C1.

Row 2: Sc join C2, sc in next st, sc blo in next st, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 3 sts, Lng fldc in next st, *(sc blo in next 3 sts, Lng fldc in

next 3 sts) twice, **sc blo** in next 3 sts, **Lng fldc** in next st; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C2. **Row 3: Sc join** C1, sc in next st, **sc blo** in next 4 sts, (**Lng fldc** in next st, **sc blo** in next st, **Lng fldc** in next st, **sc blo** in next st) twice, **sc blo** in next 8 sts, (**Lng fldc** in next st, **sc blo** in next st) twice; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C1.

Row 4: Sc join C2, sc in next st, Lng fldc in next 2 sts, sc blo in next 5 sts, Lng fldc in next st, *sc blo in next 5 sts, Lng fldc in next 5 sts, sc blo in next 5 sts, Lng fldc in next st; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C2.

Row 5: Sc join C1, sc in next st, sc blo in next 2 sts, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st, sc blo in next 3 sts, *sc blo in next 2 sts, (Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st) twice, sc blo in next 4 sts, (Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st) twice, sc blo in next 2 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C1.

Row 6: Sc join C2, sc in next st, sc blo in next 5 sts, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, *Lng fldc in next 2 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C2.

Row 7: Sc join C1, sc in next st, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next 5 sts, *sc blo in next 4 sts, (Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st) 4 times, sc blo in next 4 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C1.

Row 8: Sc join C2, sc in next st, sc blo in next 3 sts, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 2 sts, *sc blo in next st, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 3 sts, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 2 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C2.

Row 9: Sc join C1, sc in next st, sc blo in next 6 sts, Lng

fldc in next 2 sts, *Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next 13 sts, Lng fldc in next 2 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C1.

Row 10: Sc join C2, sc in next st, sc blo in next 3 sts, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 2 sts, *sc blo in next st, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 3 sts, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next 3 sts, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 3 sts, sc blo in next 2 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, fasten off C2.

Row 11: Sc join C1, sc in next st, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next 5 st, *sc blo in next 4 sts, (Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next st) 4 times, sc blo in next 4 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C1.

Row 12: Sc join C2, sc in next st, sc blo in next 5 sts, Lng fldc in next 3 sts, *Lng fldc in next 2 sts, sc blo in next 5 sts, Lng fldc in next st, sc blo in next 5 sts, Lng fldc in next 3 sts; rep from * to last 2 sts, sc in last 2 sts, fasten off C2.

Row 13: Sc join C1, sc in next st, sc blo in next 2 sts, (Lng fldc in next st, sc in next st) twice, sc blo in next 2 sts, *sc blo in next 2 sts, (Lng fldc in next st, sc in next st) twice, sc blo in next 4 sts, (Lng fldc in next st, sc in next st) twice, sc blo in next 2 sts, fasten off C1.

Row 14: Rep Row 4.

Row 15: Rep Row 3.

Row 16: Rep Row 2.

Rep Rows 1-16 until Throw measures 43"

FINISHING

Fringe

Tie ends of 2 rows together across both sides of Throw. Trim Fringe to 4½" long or to desired length.


