Staple Stitch Knit Beanie



TYPE: Knit

DESIGNER: Amy Gunderson for Premier® Yarns

SIZES:

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Circumference: 17¾ (19½, 21¼)”

Height: 8¾ (9, 9¼)” (with brim folded up)

GAUGE:

18 sts x 24 rows = 4” in St st with C1 and C2 held together

Save time, check your gauge.

MATERIALS:

[Premier® Yarns Trinket™ \(75% Acrylic, 25% Nylon; 1.76oz/50g, 437yds/400m\)](#)

- C1A: 2161-01 Citrine – 1 ball
- C1B: 2161-02 Amber – 1 ball
- C1C: 2161-03 Rose Quartz – 1 ball
- C1D: 2161-04 Amethyst – 1 ball
- C1E: 2161-05 Tourmaline – 1 ball
- C1F: 2161-06 Sapphire – 1 ball
- C1G: 2161-07 Jade – 1 ball
- C1H: 2161-08 Tiger’s Eye – 1 ball
- C1I: 2161-09 Obsidian – 1 ball

[Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Worsted \(100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m\)](#)

- C2A: 100-88 Butter – 1 ball
- C2B: 100-30 Glass – 1 ball
- C2C: 100-10 Aubergine – 1 ball
- C2D: 100-91 Lake – 1 ball
- C2E: 100-54 Coral – 1 ball
- C2F: 100-20 Orchid – 1 ball
- C2G: 100-55 Soft Peach – 1 ball
- C2H: 100-75 Berry – 1 ball
- C2I: 100-31 Peacock – 1 ball

NEEDLES & NOTIONS:

- [US Sizes 8 \(5 mm\) & 6 \(4 mm\) set of dpns or size needed to obtain gauge](#)
- [Tapestry needle](#)
- [Stitch marker](#)

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Decreasing.
- Working in the round on double-pointed needles.

STITCH GUIDE

K2, P2 Ribbing (*multiple of 4 sts*)

Rnd 1: *K2, p2; rep from * to end.

Rep Rnd 1 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Trinket is a fun carry-along yarn that has colorful tweedy nubs to give your project a complex and interesting effect! One strand each of Trinket and Everyday are held together throughout this project. Match the color and letter of Everyday and Trinket according to the materials list.

HAT

With smaller dpns and one strand of each yarn held together, cast on 80 (88, 96) sts. Pm and join to work in the rnd, being careful not to twist. Work in **K2, P2 Ribbing** for 2". Switch to larger dpns. Work in St st until piece measures 8½ (8¾, 9)" from cast-on edge.

SHAPE CROWN

Rnd 1: *K6, k2tog; rep from * to end – 10 (11, 12) sts dec'd, 70 (77, 84) sts rem.

Even Rnds 2-12: Knit.

Rnd 3: *K5, k2tog; rep from * to end – 10 (11, 12) sts dec'd, 60 (66, 72) sts rem.

Rnd 5: *K4, k2tog; rep from * to end – 10 (11, 12) sts dec'd, 50 (55, 60) sts rem.

Rnd 7: *K3, k2tog; rep from * to end – 10 (11, 12) sts dec'd, 40 (44, 48) sts rem.

Rnd 9: *K2, k2tog; rep from * to end – 10 (11, 12) sts dec'd, 30 (33, 36) sts rem.

Rnd 11: *K1, k2tog; rep from * to end – 10 (11, 12) sts dec'd, 20 (22, 24) sts rem.

Rnd 13: *K2tog; rep from * to end – 10 (11, 12) sts dec'd, 10 (11, 12) sts rem.

Cut yarn leaving an 8" tail. Thread onto tapestry needle and pass through rem live sts. Pull taut to close.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block lightly.
