FirstStudio® Litelgloo

The FirstStudio Litelgloo is a tabletop shooting enclosure for achieving soft, nearly shadowless lighting when shooting items for catalogs, promotion and online auction. Each Litelgloo comes with removable white and blue sweeps for shooting on seamless backgrounds.

This manual covers:

- Opening the Litelgloo
- Positioning the camera
- Sweep instructions (optional)
- Lighting the Litelgloo
- Folding the Litelgloo



Opening the Litelgloo Figures 1-9

1. Open the protective carrying bag.
2. Remove the Litelgloo from the protective carry bag
- Large Litelgloo only:** The large size comes folded in layers to 1/3 its size. Just pull the layers apart and the box will pop open flat.
3. The sidewalls are stack folded into two layers.
4. Pull one layer edge away from the other layer.
5. The box is now opened half way.
6. Grab the box frame at the inside corner and pull out.
7. The Litelgloo will open fully.
8. Position the box on your shooting surface. The front of the Litelgloo (with the port doors) should sit close to the front of the shooting surface so that the camera lens can be positioned close to the doors' opening.
9. The Litelgloo completely open.

Positioning the Camera

10. The front of the Litelgloo has two (2) sewn-on, hinged doors with Velcro® tabs on the top, bottom and middle of the inside edge. This allows the camera to be positioned high, low and center. the Velcro on the inside edge allows the doors to be closed when the camera is set high or low. **Figure 10**
11. The door can be held open with the sewn-on Vecro to the sides of the Litelgloo. Either or both doors can be held open. This allows shooting off center of the Litelgloo. **Figure 11**

Sweep Installation (optional)

12. The Litelgloo comes with a blue sweep and a white sweep for shooting seamless backgrounds.

Velcro tabs are sewn on the inside of the Litelgloo for positioning the sweeps. **Figure 12**

Lighting the Litelgloo

13. This is a typical set up for shooting items in the Litelgloo. **Figure 13**

Folding the Litelgloo Figures 14 – 16

- 14-16. To fold the Litelgloo, push one edge of the box to the opposite edge and then fold the box onto itself.

Large Litelgloo Only:

The large Litelgloo can be folded further by grabbing the opposite edges of the flat folded frame and twisting the frame to fold onto itself.
