

**Granny Accent Blanket** 

### **FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:**

Length: 35" Width: 33½"

#### **MATERIALS**

**Premier® Yarns** *DK Colors® Batik* (100% Acrylic; 5oz/140g, 383yds/350m)

• 2053-02 Unicorn - 4 skeins

Hook: US Size G-6 (4 mm) or size needed to

obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle

#### GAUGE

15 dc x 10 rows = 4"

Save time, check your gauge.

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Chain stitches and working in chain spaces.
- Single, double and half double crochet stitches.
- Seaming pieces together.
- Working in rounds.

#### **BLANKET**

Granny Squares (make 12)

Ch 4, join with sl st to first ch to form a ring **Rnd 1**: Ch 3 (counts as dc throughout), 2 dc in ring, \*ch 2, 3 dc in ring; rep from \* two more times, join with hdc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 2: Ch 3, (2 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in same sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* two more times, join with a sc to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 3: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp\*\*, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ending last rep at \*\*, join with a sc to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 4: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, \*ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp\*\*, ch 1, 3 dc in next ch-1 sp; rep from \* around, ending last rep at \*\*, join with a sc to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-3.

Rnd 5: Ch 3, 2 dc in same sp, \*ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-1 sp, ch 1) to next ch-2 sp, (3 dc, ch 2, 3 dc) in next ch-2 sp; rep from \* around, ch 1, join to 3<sup>rd</sup> ch of beg ch-3 with a sl st. Fasten off.

Using photo as a guide, sew 6 squares together side by side to form a strip. Rep previous step with 6 remaining squares to form a second strip.

#### Body

With RS of first Granny Square strip facing, join yarn with a sl st in ch-2 sp of upper right corner of strip

**Row 1:** Ch 3, dc in each dc and each ch sp across the strip, turn — 126 dc.

**Row 2:** Ch 3, dc in each dc across, turn.

Rep Row 2 until Blanket measures 26". Sew the second Granny Square strip to the last row. Fasten off, weave in ends.
