FREE KNIT PATTERN

Woodland Cardigan



TYPE: Knit

DESIGNER: Amy Gunderson for Premier® Yarns

SIZES

XS (S, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X)

Shown in Small size.

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Bust: 34 (38, 42, 46, 50) (54, 58, 62, 66)''

Length: 19 (19½, 20½, 21, 21¾) (22¼, 23¼, 23¾, 24½)''

GAUGE:

20 sts x 29 rows = 4'' in St st with C1 and C2 held together

Save time, check your gauge.

MATERIALS:

Premier® Yarns Trinket™ (75% Acrylic, 20% Nylon; 1.76oz/50g, 437yds/400m)

- C1: 2161-05 Tourmaline – 2 (3, 3, 3, 4) (4, 4, 5, 5) balls

Premier® Yarns Cotton Sprout® (100% Cotton; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m)

- C2: 1149-28 Bark – 5 (5, 6, 7, 8) (9, 10, 11, 12) balls

NEEDLE & NOTIONS:

- US Sizes 6 (4 mm) & 4 (3.5 mm) straight and 40'' circular (for front edging) or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle, stitch marker, stitch holders, 6 (6, 6, 7, 7) (7, 8, 8, 8) – ½'' buttons

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Knit and purl stitches.
- Increasing and decreasing.
- Holding two strands of yarn together.
- Adding pockets.
- Seaming with mattress stitch.

STITCH GUIDE

K1, P1 Ribbing (*odd number of sts*)

Row 1 (RS): *K1, p1; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): *P1, k1; rep from * to last st, p1.

Rep Rows 1-2 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Trinket is a fun carry-along yarn that has colorful tweedy nubs to give your project a complex and interesting effect! One strand each of Trinket and Cotton Sprout DK are held together throughout this project. Cardigan is knit flat in pieces and seamed.

CARDIGAN

BACK

HEM

With smaller needle and both yarns held together, cast on 87 (97, 107, 117, 127) (137, 147, 157, 167) sts. Work in **K1, P1 Ribbing** for 8 rows. Switch to larger needle. Work even in St st until piece measures 13 (13, 13¼, 13¼, 13½) (13½, 13¾, 13¾, 14)” from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row.

RAGLAN SHAPING

Bind off 3 (5, 6, 7, 8) (9, 10, 11, 12) sts at the beg of next 2 rows – 81 (87, 95, 103, 111) (119, 127, 135, 143) sts rem.

Dec row (RS): K2, ssk, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 – 2 sts dec'd.

Next row (WS): Purl.

Rep these 2 rows, 20 (22, 22, 22, 22) (23, 23, 23, 23) more times – 39 (41, 49, 57, 65) (71, 79, 87, 95) sts rem.

- (-, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) SIZES ONLY

Dec row (RS): K2, ssk, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 – 2 sts dec'd.

Dec row (WS): P2, p2tog, purl to last 4 sts, ssp, p2 – 2 sts dec'd.

Rep these 2 rows, - (-, 1, 3, 5) (6, 8, 10, 12) more times - - (-, 41, 41, 41) (43, 43, 43, 43) sts rem.

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ALL SIZES

Bind off all sts.

POCKET LINERS (MAKE 2)

With both yarns held together and larger needle, cast on 25 sts. Work in St st until piece measures 5". Break yarn, place sts on holder.

LEFT FRONT

Note: Keep track of how many rows are worked in each section so you can match the number on the Right Front.

With smaller needle and both yarns held together, cast on 41 (45, 51, 55, 61) (65, 71, 75, 81) sts. Work in **K1, P1 Ribbing** for 8 rows. Switch to larger needle. Work even in St st until piece measures 7" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row.

Pocket Row (RS): K8 (10, 13, 15, 18) (20, 23, 25, 28), place next 25 sts on holder, knit across held Pocket sts, knit to end.

Cont in St st until piece measures 10 (10, 10¼, 10¼, 10½) (10½, 10¾, 10¾, 11)", ending with a WS row.

SHAPE NECK

Dec Row (RS): Knit to last 4 sts, ssk, k2 – 1 st dec'd at Neck edge. Rep Dec Row every 6 rows, 0 (0, 0, 3, 3) (5, 5, 9, 9) more times, then every 4 rows, 13 (13, 14, 10, 11) (9, 10, 5, 6) times – 14 (14, 15, 14, 15) (15, 16, 15, 16) total sts dec'd at Neck.

At the same time, when piece measures 13 (13, 13¼, 13¼, 13½) (13½, 13¾, 13¾, 14)" from cast-on edge, ending with a WS row, move to next section.

RAGLAN SHAPING

Note: Continue to work Neck decs as established.

Bind off 3 (5, 6, 7, 8) (9, 10, 11, 12) sts at the beg of the next row. Work a WS row even.

Dec Row (RS): K2, ssk, work as established to end – 1 st dec'd at armhole edge.

Rep these 2 rows, 20 (22, 22, 22, 22) (23, 23, 23, 23) more times.

- (-, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) SIZES ONLY

Dec row (RS): **K2, ssk, work as established to end – 1 st dec'd.**

Dec Row (WS): Purl to last 4 sts, ssp, p2 – 1 st dec'd.

Rep these 2 rows, - (-, 1, 3, 5) (6, 8, 10, 12) more times.

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ALL SIZES

After all Neck and Raglan decs are complete, 3 sts rem. K3tog, fasten off last st.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for Left Front to Shape Neck section.

SHAPE NECK

Dec row (RS): K2, k2tog, knit to end – 1 st dec'd at Neck edge. Rep Dec Row every 6 rows, 0 (0, 0, 3, 3) (5, 5, 9, 9) more times, then every 4 rows, 13 (13, 14, 10, 11) (9, 10, 5, 6) times – 14 (14, 15, 14, 15) (15, 16, 15, 16) total sts dec'd at Neck.

At the same time, when piece measures 13 (13, 13¼, 13¼, 13½) (13½, 13¾, 13¾, 14)” from cast-on edge, ending with a RS row, move to next section.

RAGLAN SHAPING

Note: Continue to work Neck decs as established.

Bind off 3 (5, 6, 7, 8) (9, 10, 11, 12) sts at the beg of the next row.

Dec Row (RS): Work as established to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 – 1 st dec'd at armhole edge.

Rep these 2 rows, 20 (22, 22, 22, 22) (23, 23, 23, 23) more times.

- (-, M, L, 1X) (2X, 3X, 4X, 5X) Sizes Only

Dec Row (RS): Work as established to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 – 1 st dec'd.

Dec Row (WS): P2, p2tog, purl to end – 1 st dec'd.

Rep these 2 rows, - (-, 1, 3, 5) (6, 8, 10, 12) more times.

ALL SIZES

After all Neck and Raglan decs are complete, 3 sts rem. K3tog, fasten off last st.

SLEEVES

With smaller needle and both yarns held together, cast on 45 (45, 47, 47, 49) (49, 51, 51, 53) sts. Work in **K1, P1 Ribbing** for 8 rows. Switch to larger needle. Work even in St st for 4 rows.

Inc Row (RS): K2, m1, knit to last 2 sts, m1, k2 – 2 sts inc'd. Work 11 (9, 7, 5, 5) (5, 3, 3, 3) rows even in St st. Rep these 12 (10, 8, 6, 6) (6, 4, 4, 4) rows, 5 (8, 9, 5, 13) (15, 9, 15, 21) more times – 57 (63, 67, 59, 77) (81, 71, 83, 97) sts. Rep Inc row. Work 13 (11, 9, 7, 7) (7, 5, 5, 5) rows even in St st. Rep these 14

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(12, 10, 8, 8) (8, 6, 6, 6) rows, 1 (0, 1, 7, 1) (0, 9, 5, 1) more time(s) – 61 (65, 71, 75, 81) (85, 91, 95, 101) sts.

Work even in St st until Sleeve measures 18” or desired length to underarm.

RAGLAN SHAPING

Bind off 3 (5, 6, 7, 8) (9, 10, 11, 12) sts at the beg of next 2 rows – 55 (55, 59, 61, 65) (67, 71, 73, 77) sts rem.

Dec Row (RS): K2, ssk, knit to last 4 sts, k2tog, k2 – 2 sts dec’d. Work 3 rows even in St st. Rep these 4 rows, 0 (2, 2, 3, 3) (4, 4, 5, 5) more times – 53 (49, 53, 53, 57) (57, 61, 61, 65) sts rem.

Rep Dec Row. Work a WS row even in St st. Rep these 2 rows, 18 (16, 18, 18, 20) (20, 22, 22, 24) more times – 14 sts rem. Bind off all sts.

FINISHING

Weave in ends. Block pieces to finished measurements. Using mattress st, sew raglan seams, Sleeve and side seams. Sew pocket to WS of Fronts using mattress st or whipstitch.

POCKET EDGING

Place held Pocket sts onto smaller needle. With both yarns held together, beg with a RS row, work 6 rows in **K1, P1 Ribbing**. Bind off all sts in patt. Sew sides of Edging to RS of Fronts.

FRONT EDGING

With smaller circular needle and both yarns held together, with RS facing and beg at lower Right Front, pick up and knit 55 (55, 57, 57, 59) (59, 61, 61, 63) sts along lower Right Front to beg of Neck Shaping, pm, 37 (40, 43, 46, 49) (52, 55, 57, 60) sts along upper Right Front, 12 sts along top of Sleeve, 37 (39, 39, 39, 39) (41, 41, 41, 41) sts along Back Neck, 12 sts along top of Sleeve, 37 (40, 43, 46, 49) (52, 55, 57, 60) along upper Left Front to beg of Neck shaping, and 55 (55, 57, 57, 59) (59, 61, 61, 63) sts along lower Left Front – 245 (253, 263, 269, 279) (287, 297, 301, 311) sts. Work 3 rows even in **K1, P1 Ribbing**.

Buttonhole Row (RS): Work 5 (5, 7, 9, 11) (11, 5, 5, 7) sts in established rib, *yo twice, work 10 (10, 10, 8, 8) (8, 8, 8, 8) sts in established rib; rep from *4 (4, 4, 5, 5) (5, 6, 6, 6) more times, yo twice, sl m, work in established rib to end.

Next Row (WS): Work in established rib to 1 st before m, *ssk (next st tog with first yo), p2tog tbl (other yo tog with following st), work in rib to 1 st before next double yo; rep from * for each double yo, work in rib to end. Work 2 more rows even in rib. Bind off all sts in patt.


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Block edgings. Sew buttons to Left Front opposite buttonholes. Weave in rem ends.
