

Utrecht Art Supplies History: The Palette as a Painting Support



There is a long tradition of painting thumbnail sketches and even fully realized paintings directly on wooden palettes. Paintings rendered on iconic kidney-shaped boards range from careful renderings, improvised sketches and collaborations between dozens of painters.
