## Pastel Bloom Blanket

# Pastel Bloom Blanket



**TYPE:** Crochet

**DESIGNER:** Liz Salazar for Premier® Yarns

**FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:**

**Width:** 40"

**Length:** 62"

**GAUGE:**

4 blocks = 4" in patt

**Save time, check your gauge.**

**MATERIALS:**

**Premier® Yarns Bloom® Chunky Big**  
(100% Acrylic, 7oz/200g, 200m/218 yds)

- 2035-03 Snapdragon – 8 balls  
- OR -

**Premier® Yarns Bloom® Chunky** (100%  
Acrylic, 3.5oz/100g, 100m/109 yds)

- 1114-13 Snapdragon – 16 balls

**HOOKS & NOTIONS:**

- **US Size L-11 (8 mm) or**  
**size needed to obtain gauge**
- **Tapestry needle**

**SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:**

- Chain, slip stitches, single and double crochet stitches.
- Working in the corner-to-corner crochet technique.
- Working in rounds.

## PATTERN NOTES

This Blanket is crocheted using the corner-to-corner technique. Begin in the lower right corner and increase each row diagonally, then work even, and finally decrease each row ending in the upper left corner. This blanket consists of 4 corner-to-corner panels that are seamed together.

## BLANKET

### Panel (make 4)

#### Increase Section

Ch 6.

**Row 1:** Dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc in next 2 chs, turn – 1 block.

**Row 2:** Ch 6, dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc in next 2 chs, (sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of first block, turn – 2 blocks.

**Row 3:** Ch 6, dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc in next 2 chs, \*(sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of next block; rep from \* to end, turn – 1 block inc'd.

**Rows 4-10:** Rep Row 3 – 10 blocks after Row 10.

#### Even Section

**Row 1:** Ch 6, dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc in next 2 chs, \*(sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of next block; rep from \* to last ch-3 sp, sl st in last ch-3 sp, turn, sl st in next 3 dc – 10 blocks.

**Row 2:** \*(Sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of next block; rep from \* to end, turn – 10 blocks.

**Rows 3-42:** Rep Rows 1-2, 20 times – 10 blocks.

#### Decrease Section

**Row 1:** Ch 6, dc in 4<sup>th</sup> ch from hook, dc in next 2 chs, \*(sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of next block; rep from \* to last ch-3 sp, sl st in last ch-3 sp, turn, sl st in next 3 dc – 10 blocks.

**Row 2:** \*(Sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of next block; rep from \* to last ch-3 sp, sl st in last ch-3 sp, turn, sl st in next 3 dc – 9 blocks rem.

**Rows 3-9:** Rep Row 2 – 2 blocks rem.

**Row 10:** (Sl st, ch 3, 3 dc) in ch-3 sp of next block, sl st in next block – 1 block rem. Fasten off.

Panel should measure approximately 10" wide x 62" tall.

## FINISHING

Seam panels together as shown in photo using mattress st.

#### Border

With RS facing, join yarn with a sl st in any corner.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, sc evenly around, at a rate of 2-3 sc per block, working 3 sc for each corner, join with a sl st in first sc.

Fasten off, weave in ends. Block lightly.
