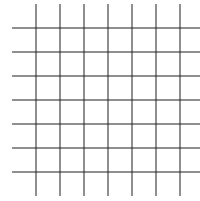

HOW TO USE THE GRID OVERLAYS

SQUARE GRIDS

■ Square grids allow artists to segment their work area into equal sections, making it easier to manage the spacing of their work area.

■ The most basic application of this is to project one of the Inspire 1200's square grid overlays onto a blank canvas or wall, then lightly trace over the lines with graphite or charcoal.

HOW TO USE THE GRID OVERLAYS

SQUARE GRIDS

■ A slightly more advanced application for the grids is to use them to segment an image that will serve as the background for the painting.

■ First, select the background image and project it onto a wall or canvas. Then, select which grid you want overlaid on top of the image.

■ Now you can trace the background image and paint it onto your wall or canvas one section at a time.

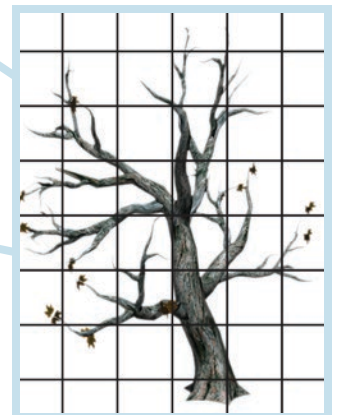
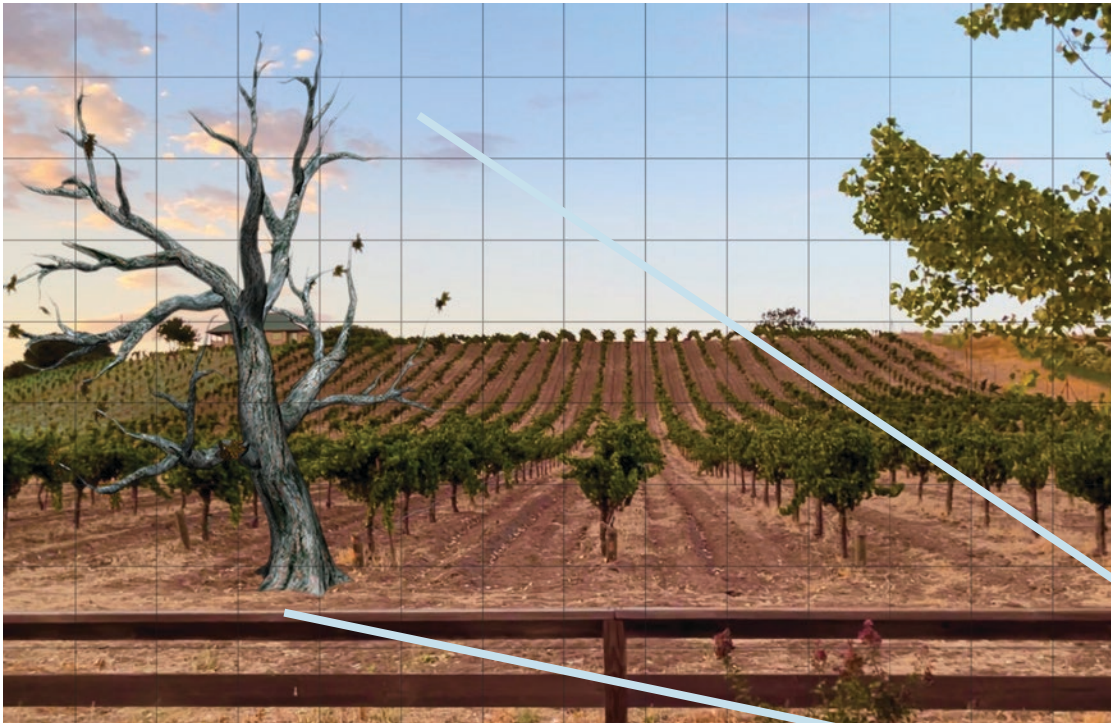


HOW TO USE THE GRID OVERLAYS

SQUARE GRIDS

■ Square grids can even make it easier to take small sketches or photographs and free-hand them onto a larger background.

■ First, use the grids to section off your sketch or photograph. Next, project the exact same grid onto the background image. Then, free-hand each square of the smaller image onto the corresponding square of the larger image.

HOW TO USE THE GRID OVERLAYS

PERSPECTIVE GRIDS

■ Perspective grids allow you to add depth to a blank wall/canvas and background image.

■ The Inspire 1200 comes with perspective grids whose vanishing point leads left, right, and center. Use these grids to aid the free-handing of details onto your painting.

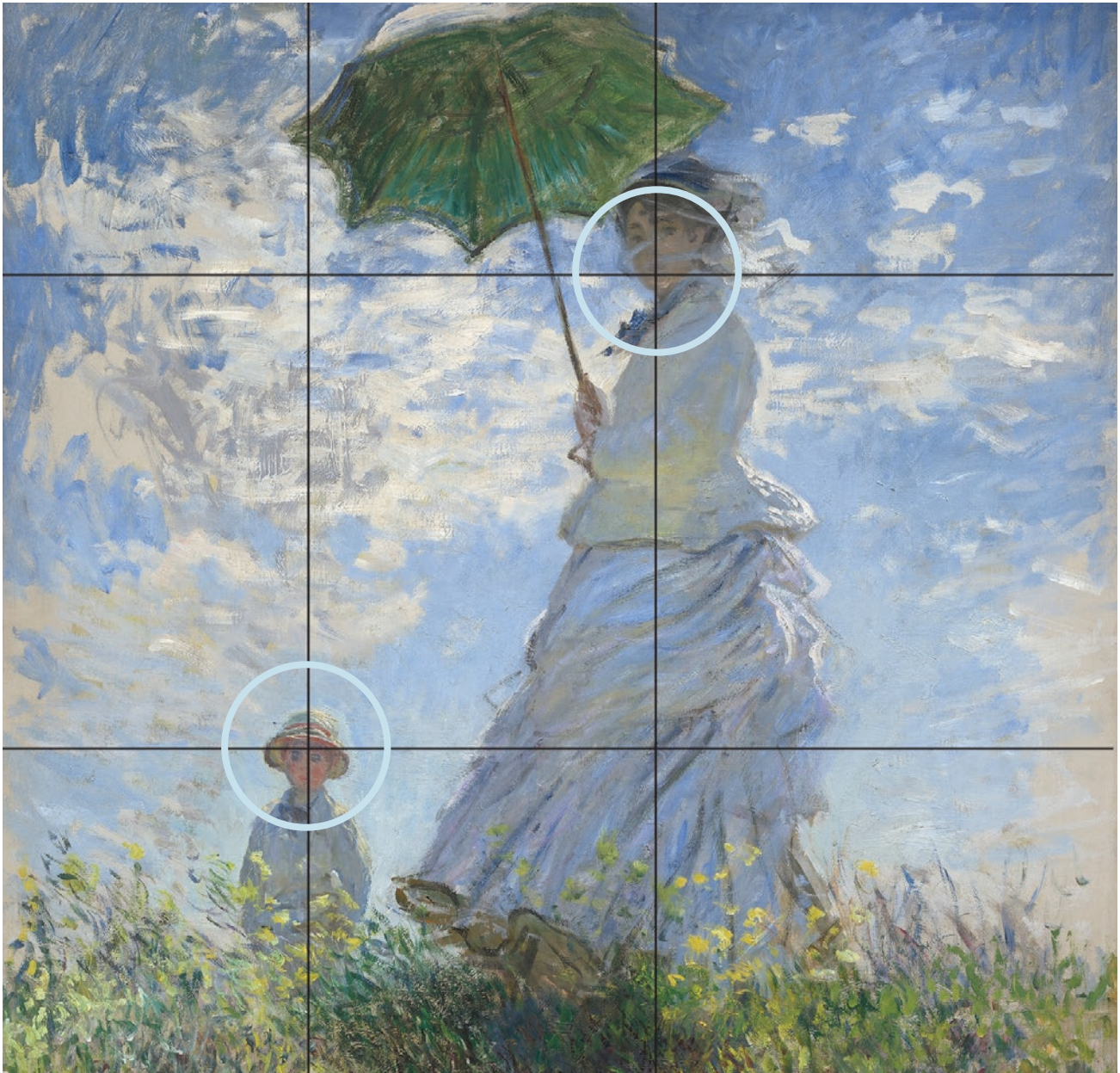

RULE-OF-THIRDS GRIDS

- These grids can be used to highlight adherence to the Rule-of-Thirds where the most interesting parts fall on intersecting lines.

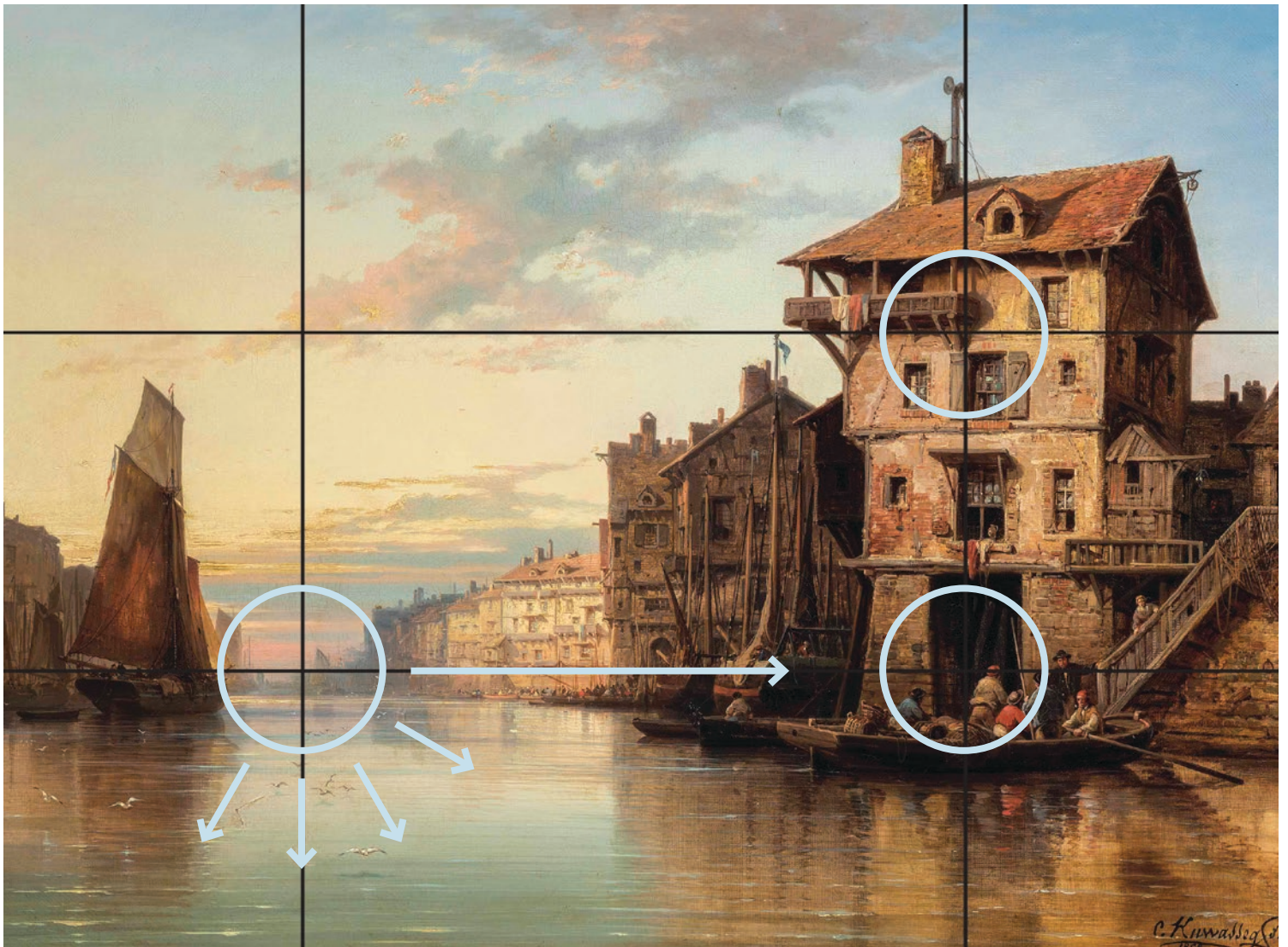

HOW TO USE THE GRID OVERLAYS

RULE-OF-THIRDS GRIDS

- In addition to being a useful tool for teaching the Rule-of-Thirds, these grids can help new artists incorporate the concept into their artwork.
- Simply project the grid onto a wall or canvas and paint the focal point of your painting at the intersections of the grid lines.
