- No. 6 Sap Green

- No. 7 Mix Sap Green and Hooker's Green Dark
- No. 8 Mix Ultramarine Blue Dark and Burnt Umber
- No. 9 Burnt Umber
- No. 10 Prussian Blue
- No. 11 Mix Sap Green and Burnt Umber (ratio 2:1)

STEP



Define your work area before beginning painting with masking tape. Make a light sketch. Don't make a detailed sketch, to show the baselines it is enough. Moisten the sky area with clean water and add color No. 1 on the wet layer. Dry the painted layer or leave it to dry.

STEP



Wash the bottom part of the painting with clean water and add colors No. 2, 3 and 4 to the wet layer. Allow the paint to dry completely.

STEP



Paint the bushes in the background with color No. 6. Then add color No. 7 on the still wet layer. Dry the painted layer. Now, paint the trunk of the palm tree with color No. 8. and palm leaves with colors No. 6 and No. 11. Once again, let the painting dry completely.

STEP



Add details to the bushes with color No. 10. Paint one more layer on the water with color No. 10. and the shadow from the palm tree in color No. 5. Add a layer on the palm tree trunk in color No. 9. And finally, paint additional details on the palm's leaves with color No. 7 and No. 11.
