Staple Stitch Crochet Beanie



TYPE: Crochet

DESIGNER: Premier® Yarns Design Team

SIZES:

Adult Small (Medium, Large)

FINISHED MEASUREMENTS:

Circumference: 18 (20, 22)''

Height: 8¾ (9, 9¼)'' (with brim folded up)

GAUGE:

12 sc x 15 rnds = 4'' with C1 and C2 held together and larger hook

Save time, check your gauge.

MATERIALS:

[Premier® Yarns Trinket™ \(75% Acrylic, 25% Nylon; 1.76oz/50g, 437yds/400m\)](#)

- C1A: 2161-01 Citrine – 1 ball
- C1B: 2161-02 Amber – 1 ball
- C1C: 2161-03 Rose Quartz – 1 ball
- C1D: 2161-04 Amethyst – 1 ball
- C1E: 2161-05 Tourmaline – 1 ball
- C1F: 2161-06 Sapphire – 1 ball
- C1G: 2161-07 Jade – 1 ball
- C1H: 2161-08 Tiger's Eye – 1 ball
- C1I: 2161-09 Obsidian – 1 ball

[Premier® Yarns Anti-Pilling Everyday® Worsted \(100% Anti-Pilling Acrylic; 3.5oz/100g, 180yds/165m\)](#)

- C2A: 100-88 Butter – 1 ball
- C2B: 100-30 Glass – 1 ball
- C2C: 100-10 Aubergine – 1 ball
- C2D: 100-91 Lake – 1 ball
- C2E: 100-54 Coral – 1 ball
- C2F: 100-20 Orchid – 1 ball
- C2G: 100-55 Soft Peach – 1 ball
- C2H: 100-75 Berry – 1 ball
- C2I: 100-31 Peacock – 1 ball

HOOKS & NOTIONS:

- [US Sizes I-9 \(5.5 mm\) & H-8 \(5 mm\) or size needed to obtain gauge](#)
- [Tapestry needle](#)

SKILLS/TECHNIQUES USED IN THIS PATTERN:

- Chains, yarnover slip stitch, and single crochet stitches.
- Decreasing.
- Working in flat and in the round.

STITCH GUIDE

Yarnover Slip Stitch (YSS): Yo, insert hook into st indicated, pull yarn through st and then through the 2 loops on the hook.

Yarnover Slip Stitch Ribbing (*any number of sts*)

Row 1: YSS in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across, turn.

Row 2: Ch 1, YSS in blo of each st across, turn.

Rep Row 2 for patt.

PATTERN NOTES

Trinket is a fun carry-along yarn that has colorful tweedy nubs to give your project a complex and interesting effect! One strand each of Trinket and Everyday are held together throughout this project. Match the color and letter of Everyday and Trinket according to the materials list.

HAT

With smaller hook and one strand of each yarn held together, ch 8. Work Row 1 of **Yarnover Slip Stitch Ribbing** – 7 sts. Work in **Yarnover Slip Stitch Ribbing** for 54 (60, 66) total rows.

Bring ends of Ribbing tog and sl st ends tog.

HAT BODY

Rnd 1: Ch 1, work 54 (60, 66) sc evenly along side of Ribbing. Do not join. Place marker on first st of rnd and work in continuous rnds. Switch to larger hook.

Rnd 2: Sc in each sc around.

Rep Rnd 2 until piece measures 8½” from bottom of Ribbing.

SHAPE CROWN

Rnd 1: *Sc2tog, sc in next 7 (8, 9) sc; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, 48 (54, 60) sc rem.

Rnd 2: *Sc2tog, sc in next 6 (7, 8) sc; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, 42 (48, 54) sc rem.

Rnd 3: *Sc2tog, sc in next 5 (6, 7) sc; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, 36 (42, 48) sc rem.

Rnd 4: *Sc2tog, sc in next 4 (5, 6) sc; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, 30 (36, 42) sc rem.

CONTINUED

Rnd 5: *Sc2tog, sc in next 3 (4, 5) sc; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, 24 (30, 36) sc rem.

Rnd 6: *Sc2tog, sc in next 2 (3, 4) sc; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, 18 (24, 30) sc rem.

Rnd 7: *Sc2tog, sc in next 1 (2, 3) sc; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, 12 (18, 24) sc rem.

- (Medium, Large) Sizes:

Rnd 8: *Sc2tog, sc in next - (1, 2) sc; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, - (12, 18) sc rem.

- (-, Large Size):

Rnd 9: *Sc2tog, sc in next - (-, 1) sc; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, - (-, 12) sc rem.

All Sizes:

Next rnd: *Sc2tog; rep from * to end – 6 sc dec'd, 6 sc rem.

Cut yarn leaving an 8" tail. Thread onto tapestry needle and pass through rem sts. Pull taut to close.

FINISHING

Weave in ends and block lightly.
