

# Barrow Street Scarf

Lion Brand® Feels Like Butta®

## **SKILL LEVEL** – EASY

## SIZE

About 5 1/2 x 70 in. (14 x 178 cm), not including fringe

## **MATERIALS**

- LION BRAND® FEELS LIKE BUTTA® (Art. #215)
   #108 Dusty Blue 1 ball
- LION BRAND® double pointed needles size 7 (4.5 mm), set of 5
- LION BRAND® stitch markers
- LION BRAND® large-eyed blunt needle

# **GAUGE**

28 sts + 22 rows = about 4 in. (10 cm) over pattern in Rows 1-24. BE SURE TO CHECK YOUR GAUGE.



## STITCH EXPLANATIONS

**cdd (center double decrease)** Slip next 2 sts as if to knit them together, knit next st, pass 2 slipped sts over the knit stitch and off the right needle – 2 sts decreased.

**ssk (slip, slip, knit)** Slip next 2 sts as if to knit, one at a time, to right needle; insert left needle into fronts of these 2 sts and knit them together -1 st decreased.

#### yo (yarn over)

An increase worked as follows:

- 1. Bring yarn to front, between the needles.
- 2. Take yarn to back, over the right needle. This creates the new st. You are now ready to proceed with the next st as instructed.

## **NOTES**

- 1. Scarf is worked in one piece, back and forth in rows of a twisted rib pattern with 3 colors of yarn forming blocks of color.
- 2. When instructed to slip (sl) a stitch, slip it as if to purl.
- 3. Fringes are attached to short ends of finished Scarf.

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## **SCARF**

With A, cast on 38 sts.

**Rows 1-5:** With A, sl 1, k2, \* p1 tbl, k1 tbl; rep from \* to last 3 sts, yo, ssk, k1.

**Row 6:** With A, sl 1, k2, \* yo, p1 tbl, k1 tbl, pass yo over the p1 and k1 and off the right needle; rep from \* to last 3 sts, yo, ssk, k1.

Rows 7-17: Rep Row 1 for 11 times.

Row 18: Rep Row 6.

Rows 19-24: Rep Row 1 for 6 times.

Rows 25-48: With B, rep Rows 1-24.

Rows 49-72: With C, rep Rows 1-24.

Rep Rows 1-72 for 4 more times.

Bind off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends.

## Fringe

Cut strands of A, B, and C about 14 in. (35.5 cm) long. For each fringe, hold 1 strand each of A, B, and C together and fold in half.

Use your fingers or a crochet hook to draw fold through short edge of piece, forming a loop. Pull ends of fringe through this loop and gently tighten.

Make 20 fringes evenly spaced along each short end of Scarf.

Trim fringe ends evenly.

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

 $\mathbf{k} = \text{knit}$ 

p = purl

rep = repeat

sl = slip

st(s) = stitch(es)

tbl = through back loop
