



## FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Length:** 14"

**Width:** 10½"

## MATERIALS

**Premier® Yarns Basix™** (100% Acrylic; 5 oz/140g, 245yds/224m)

- MC: 1115-54 Butterscotch – 1 ball
- CC1: 1115-73 Dijon Mustard – 1 ball
- CC2: 1115-72 Cherry Red – 1 ball
- CC3: 1115-75 Lime – 1 ball
- CC4: 1115-76 Spruce – 1 ball
- CC5: 1115-04 Black – 1 ball

**Hook:** US Size 7 (4.5 mm) or size needed to obtain gauge

**Notions:** Tapestry needle, 12" zipper, sewing needle and thread

## GAUGE

15 sc x 16 rows = 4"

**Save time, check your gauge.**

## Skills/techniques used in this pattern:

- Single, half double, and double crochet stitches.
- Front post, standing, and slip stitches.
- Working through the back loop.
- Working flat and in the round.
- Seaming and applique sewing.
- Sewing in a zipper.

## PATTERN NOTES

Front and Back of Purse are worked separately and seamed together. Toppings are made separately and sewn to the Front piece. The strap is crocheted, seamed together, and then sewn to the sides of the Purse. A zipper is added at the end.

## STITCH GUIDE

**Magic Ring:** Wrap yarn around your left middle finger twice, leaving a 6" tail. Insert hook under both strands and pull up a lp. Ch 1 and beg working directly into center of ring. This ring can be tightened later by pulling on the yarn tail.

## PURSE

### Top Piece/Cheese

**Row 1:** With CC1, ch 2, 2 sc in second ch from hook, turn – 2 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn – 2 sts inc'd, 4 sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last, 2 sc in last, turn – 2 sts inc'd, 6 sc.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Rows 7-10:** Rep Rows 5-6, 2 more times – 10 sc.

**Rows 11-12:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Rows 13-44:** Rep Rows 5-12, 4 more times – 34 sts.

**Row 45:** Ch 3 (counts as dc), dc in same/first st, hdc in next 2, sc in next 2, (sc in next 2, hdc in next 2, dc in next 4, hdc in next 2, sc in next 2) 2 times, sc in next 2, hdc in next 2, 2 dc in last, turn, changing to MC on last pull-through – 36 sts.

Fasten off CC1.

## Crust

**Row 46 (RS):** Ch 1, working through blo, \*sc in 2, hdc in 2, dc in 4, hdc in 2, sc in 2; rep from \* 2 more times, turn.

**Rows 47-51:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 52:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to

last, 2 sc in last, turn – 38 sc.

**Row 53:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

## Edging

**Rnd 1 (with RS facing):** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, rotate piece, work 55 sc down slice to beginning tip, 1 sc in tip, and 55 sc up the other side, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

**Rnd 2 (WS):** Ch 1, fpsc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.

**Rnds 3-5:** Ch 1, sc in each sc around, join with sl st to beg sc, turn.  
Fasten off.

## Cheese Extension

Attach CC1 to unworked loop of Row 45 from RS.

**Row 1 (RS):** Beginning with standing st, dc in first st, dc in next st, hdc in next 2, sc in next 2, (sc in next 2, hdc in next 2, dc in next 4, hdc in next 2, sc in next 2) 2 times, sc in next 2, hdc in next 2, dc in last 2. Fasten off. Tack sides of this row down with sewing needle and thread.

## Bottom of Pizza

**Row 1:** With MC, ch 2, 2 sc in second ch from hook, turn – 2 sc.

**Row 2:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 3:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, 2 sc in next sc, turn – 2 sts inc'd, 4 sc.

**Row 4:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Row 5:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, sc in each sc to last, 2 sc in last, turn – 2 sts inc'd, 6 sc.

**Row 6:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Rows 7-10:** Rep Rows 5-6, 2 more times – 10 sc.

**Rows 11-12:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

**Rows 13-44:** Rep Rows 5-12, 4 more times – 34 sts.

B Rep Rows 5-6, 2 times – 38 sts.

**Rows 49-55:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn.

## Edging

Work as for Top of Pizza.

## Pepperoni (make 2)

With CC2, begin with **Magic Ring**.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 6 sc in circle. Do not join, work in a spiral.

**Rnd 2:** 2 sc in each sc around.

**Rnd 3:** (Sc in next sc, 2 sc in next sc) around – 18 sc.

**Rnd 4:** (Sc in next 2 sc, 2 sc in next sc) around d – 24 sc.

**Rnd 5:** Loosely sl st in blo of each sc around. Fasten off.

## Half Pepperoni (make 2)

With CC2, begin with **Magic Ring**.

**Row 1 (WS):** Ch 1, 3 sc in circle, turn.

**Row 2:** 2 sc in each sc, turn – 6 sc.

**Rnd 3:** Ch 1, 2 sc in first sc, (sc in next, 2 sc in next) 2 times, 2 sc in last, turn work, ch 1, work 7 sc along flat edge, do not join.

**Rnd 4:** Loosely sl st in blo of each sc along curved portion of piece only. Fasten off.

## Black Olive (make 5)

With CC5, ch 4, join with sl st to form ring.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 1, 12 sc in ring, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

## Jalepeno (make 2)

With CC3, begin with **Magic Ring**.

**Rnd 1:** Ch 3 (counts as hdc + ch 1), (hdc in ring, ch 1)

5 times, join with sl st to second ch of beg ch-3 using CC4.

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in same st, 2 sc in ch-1 sp, (sc in next hdc, 2 sc in ch-1 sp) around, join with sl st to beg sc. Fasten off.

## Strap

With MC, ch 170.

**Row 1:** Sc in second ch from hook and each ch across, turn.

**Rows 2-6:** Ch 1, sc in each sc across, turn. Fasten off. Skipping first 8 and last 8 sc, join beg-ch edge tog with Row 6 using sl st through both thicknesses.

## Strap Edging

Join MC to unseamed edge of Strap. Sl st evenly around entire open side. Repeat for other side. Steam Strap seam so it lays flat.

## FINISHING

Sew Front and Back Edgings together, leaving center 12" of one long edge unsewn for zipper. Place zipper beneath opening and pin to hold in place. Using small stitches, sew zipper to Purse.

Sew Strap to sides of Purse.

Weave in ends.
