

Double-Sided Holiday Blocks

Looking for a decoration you can use for more than one holiday? Decorate both sides of these versatile blocks with festive holiday colors and sayings, and easily flip them as the seasons change!



HOW TO MAKE IT



STEP 1

Color one side of the blocks with Montana Acrylic Markers in Christmas colors (Red, Green, and White). Color the other side in Thanksgiving colors (Yellow, Brown, and Orange). Color the tops and sides of the blocks with a neutral color such as Gold, Silver, or White.



STEP 2

On the Christmas side of the blocks, spell out J-I-N-G-L-E with one letter per block. On another block, write "BELLS" all on the same block. Flip to the Thanksgiving side of the blocks and spell out T-H-A-N-K-S, again one letter per block. On the block with the word "BELLS," write "GIVE" on the other side.



STEP 3

This fun, quick project can be used for years to come! Make several sets for multiple holidays, including Fourth of July, Halloween, Valentine's Day, and more.
