

PACKING INFORMATION

CHERRY

DESIGNED FOR STORAGE AT 0° -2°C

BOX LINER PRODUCT NO: L212

This liner is designed to be used for 5kg of cherries stored at 0°C to 2°C, for export by seafreight. Storage time possible is dependent on variety of cherry being packed.

- * Check that printed details on box liner agree with your intended use, if not contact Amcor Flexibles Australasia or your local LifeSpan dealer.
- * The cherries should be pre-cooled to below 5°C before packing. Packing cherries without adequate pre-cooling may cause heat build up and condensation in the carton liners.
- * Cherries should be graded to remove damaged and split fruit. Only pack cherries that have good keeping quality. Initial trials should be conducted on each variety to determine available storage life.
- * Keep the cherries cool whilst packing. Return packed cherries to coolstore immediately and cool to below 2°C overnight. Do not load shipping containers until cherry temperature is down to the desired shipping temperature.
- * Ensure boxes being used do not have sharp corners or staples that will puncture the box liner.
- * Seal box liner by twisting the neck of the liner into a "rope". Secure a blue easy release clip around the neck as per Sealing Instructions.
- * Store packed boxes in cool storage between 0°C and 2°C, low temperatures are best. If boxes are removed from cool storage, the box liners must be opened.
