

Use of Wooden Boxes

LifeSpan MAP carton liners are designed to be robust. However, they are also made from thin gauge plastic film so that they are easy to handle on packing lines – both fitting the liners into the boxes and sealing the liners.

LifeSpan liners can be used effectively with most corrugated cardboard boxes, with most rigid plastic crates, and with most expanded polystyrene boxes.

Wooden boxes often have rough surfaces and sharp corners. When a LifeSpan liner is placed into a wooden box, there is a significant possibility that it will snare on a rough area of the wood and the liner will be punctured. A punctured LifeSpan liner will not deliver the expected storage performance.

It is strongly recommended that LifeSpan MAP carton liners are not used with wooden boxes.
