

# Corona measures in Switzerland – what are the next steps?

Because of the new corona virus (COVID-19), there are currently new and stringent rules in Switzerland. These rules are now eased gradually.

## Permitted again as of April 27



Hairdressing salons, massage practices, tattoo and cosmetic studios



DIY stores, garden centers, florists and market gardens



Hospitals (all types of procedures), medical, dental, physiotherapy and medical massage practices



Funerals with larger parties

## What continues to apply:

- Maintain a distance of 2 meters
- Wash your hands thoroughly and regularly
- Don't gather with more than 5 people
- Stay at home whenever possible (home office)

## Permitted again as of May 11



Schools for children of compulsory-school age (kindergarten, primary and secondary school)



All shops and markets

## Permitted again as of June 8



Upper secondary schools, vocational schools and higher education institutions



Zoos, libraries, museums and botanical gardens



Eased restriction on gatherings

## Still unclear



Large-scale events



Gastronomy/restaurants

The schedule for the easing of restrictions is not final. It might change if a lot of people become infected with the new corona virus again.
