

## Get together with as few people as possible.



- Masks compulsory in busy town and village centres, and publicly accessible indoor and outdoor areas at establishments and businesses
- Remote learning to be introduced at universities
- Masks compulsory for everyone in high schools and vocational schools
- Masks compulsory for work indoors, except in your own workspace if the recommended distance can be maintained
- Ban on public events with more than 50 people and private events with more than 10 people
- Spontaneous gatherings of more than 15 people in public places are banned
- Maximum of 4 people per table at restaurants (exception for families with children)
- Restaurants and bars must remain closed between 11.00pm and 6.00am
- Operating clubs, discos and dance venues is prohibited
- Amateur sports: ban on activities with more than 15 people; contact sports prohibited; masks and distancing indoors, masks or distancing outdoors; children in compulsory education can continue to do sports unrestricted
- Culture/arts (music, theatre, dance, etc.) for amateurs: activities with up to 15 people allowed provided masks are worn and distancing rules followed. For professionals: rehearsals and performances allowed
- Choir performances prohibited; rehearsals only allowed for professional choirs
- Work from home if possible
