



AFL MAX COVID SAFETY MEASURES

We are pumped to have guests back in the venue! We have implemented the below to ensure you have a fun and safe experience at Max!



AFL Max advises its visitors that all activities must be strictly no contact - i.e. no tackling, no bumping, no marking contests or highfives.



Staff will ensure guests adhere to the 1.5m social distancing rules and ensure the max no. of guests in a room does not exceed 1 person/2m². Strict capacity management will also assist with all distancing requirements.



Hand sanitizer units are available to customers throughout the Venue. Staff will follow strict routinely cleaning and disinfecting all areas and equipment.



AFL Max booking platform and SA Government contact tracing forms keep a record of guest attendance, venue capacity and contact details which can confidentially be shared with SA Health Authorities, should it be requested.



All staff members have certified COVID-19 Safe training.
AFL Max has appointed 2 COVID Safe Officers and Marshals to manage the COVID Safe Plan



AFL Max follows the direction and advice of police and local government at all times and continually revises and implements updated protocols as required.



We check the temperature of all our staff before shifts commence. Staff are also strictly required to call in sick, should they present any symptoms



WHAT WE NEED YOU TO DO

We need to ensure we work as a team so we can keep you, our staff and the community safe. As part of the team, we ask guests to help us by following the below.

AFL Max will ensure all guest participation adheres to physical distancing requirements of 1.5m and no more than 1 participant per 2m². Please also monitor your distance and personal contact with others ensuring no high-fives, handshakes tackling, bumping, marking contests.



Please use our hand sanitizers throughout your visit. When using the bathroom, please ensure you wash your hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. Avoid touching your eyes, nose and mouth.



Do not attend the Venue if you are feeling unwell or have been in contact with people who are sick. Contact our Bookings Team who will be happy to re-book your session or provide a refund.



AFL Max recommends all visitors download the COVIDSafe app to help in tracing the spread of COVID



Parents and guardians are welcome to drop and pick up their children, but must sign all guests in on the SA Government contact tracing form. If parents are entering the venue, but not participating in activities, they must head directly upstairs, where they can observe from above.



AFL Max requires all visitors to remain seated when consuming food and beverages.
