Court Maintenance

Courts 3,4,5,6 & 7 received a deep clean on 8 and 9 June, then follow up maintenance cleaning on 12 July and 9 August. There has been a massive improvement in the condition of the courts, particularly noticeable after heavy rain, which unfortunately we have seen a lot of this year! The hedges were trimmed back over the summer, improving the court surface as there has been less debris.

Floodlighting Update

All Court Tennis have purchased some temporary lights for coaching use on Courts 5, 6 & 7, which will improve availability of courts 1,2,3 & 4 during the darker months. The plan for court 1 is to replace the heads that are not working.
