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Item

226 USE OF SERVICE

- A. The service is intended only for communication in which the customer has a interest and shall not be used for any purpose for which a payment or other compensation shall be received by him from any other person, firm or corporation for such use, or in the collection, transmission or delivery of any communication for others.
- B. The use of the Company's services for annoying any person, or impersonating any individual, or the use of offensive language while using or conversing over the Company's equipment are prohibited. The Company may terminate the service of any customer who commits any breach of this provision or permits any person to use the service of such customer contrary to this provision or to the Regulations of the Department of Communications of the Government of Canada.
- C. No customer shall use the Company's service or permit it to be used so as to prevent a fair and proportionate use thereof by others; nor shall any customer cause or induce others to so use the service. In order to ensure a fair and proportionate use, the Company may limit the length of conversations transmitted over its facilities.
