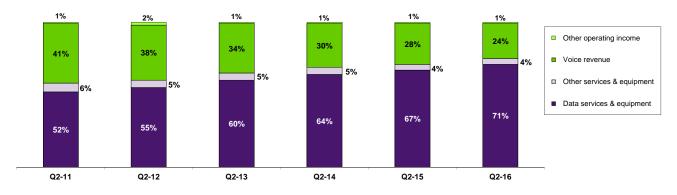

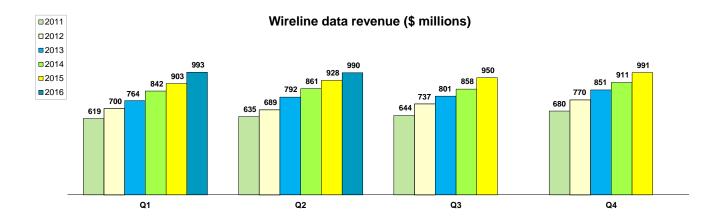
Q2 Wireline revenue profile - (% of total external wireline revenue)

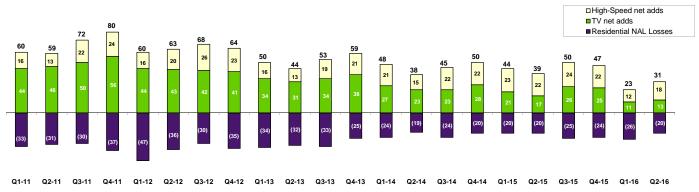

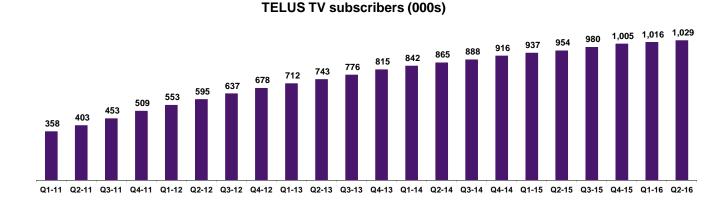

² <u>EBITDA interest coverage ratio</u> is defined as EBITDA (excluding restructuring and other costs), divided by net interest cost. Net interest cost is defined as financing costs, net of capitalized long-term debt interest, excluding employee defined benefit plans net interest, as well as recoveries on redemption and repayment of debt, calculated on a 12-month trailing basis. Any losses recorded on the redemption of debt are included in net interest. This measure is similar to the Coverage Ratio covenant in TELUS' credit facilities.

³ <u>Free cash flow</u> is calculated as EBITDA, adding: Restructuring costs net of disbursements, net employee defined benefit plans expense, the excess of share compensation expense over share compensation payments, and interest received; and deducting: employer contributions to employee defined benefit plans, interest paid, cash income taxes, capital expenditures (excluding spectrum licences and non-monetary transactions), gain on transfer of wireless spectrum licenses and net gains and equity income from real estate joint venture developments.

⁴ <u>Net debt</u> is defined as Long-term Debt (including current maturities of long-term debt) plus debt issue costs netted against long-term debt, Short-term borrowings and net derivative liabilities, less Cash and temporary investments.
