	1.	The Service is provided by the Company subject to the availability of applicable equipment and facilities.		
	2.	The Customer may use and resell the Service to its end-users.		
	3.	The Customer or its end-users may use the Service for research, experimental and education purposes only. The Service may not be used by the Customer or its end-users for commercial traffic, including general Internet transit traffic from the Customer to any end-user.		
	4.	The Customer shall be responsible for the selection, supply, installation and maintenance of all data, equipment, software and services necessary for interconnection to the Company at each SDP at each Customer Site, including all customer premises equipment.		
	5.	If any customer premises equipment is believed by the Company to cause hazard or service obstruction, the Customer shall use commercially reasonable efforts to address any hazard or obstruction at the Company's request.		
	6.	The Company shall be responsible for installing and maintaining the Network Facilities required to provide the Service to the SDP at each Customer Site.
