GUEST INFORMATION

Welcome to NRMA Shellharbour Beachside Holiday Park

We're on-hand to help if you need anything – just pop into reception. Otherwise, keep this map handy so you know what's around, along with our park rules so that everyone stays safe and has a great time.

ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE: Check in is available from 2pm for cabins and 11am for sites on the day of your scheduled arrival, unless you've made prior arrangements with us. All rooms/sites need to be vacated by 10 am on the day of your departure. If you'd like to check out before reception opens or extend your stay, please come see us at reception and we'll be happy to help.

AMENITIES: Amenities block is located in the middle of the property. Please see the map provided for location. Children under 12 years of age must be accompanied by an adult and supervised at all times. Please consider others when using these facilities and leave them in a neat and tidy condition. Facilities are cleaned daily and the cleaning times are displayed at the entrance to each block.

BBQ AREAS: Guest BBQ areas are available throughout the property for your enjoyment and are marked on the park map. Please remember to leave the area clean after use and please note that open fires are prohibited for fire safety reasons.

BICYCLES/SCOOTERS: Please only use these during daylight hours and observe all road rules, including wearing helmets and necessary protective gear. Children must be supervised at all times. Please note: Electric scooters and electric skateboards are not permitted at any time.

CAMP KITCHEN: Camp kitchens are available for use by all guests. Please consider others when using these facilities and clean the area after use.

CCTV: Please be aware that surveillance cameras are used within the property.

DUMP POINT: A dump point is available for the use of guests. You can find the location of this on the map.

EMERGENCY ASSEMBLY POINT: To ensure the safety of all guests, we ask that you familiarise yourself with our emergency assembly area, which you can see marked on the map. In the case of an emergency, please stay calm and follow the instructions from staff members.

E-SCOOTERS/E-SKATEBOARDS: Due to the risk of injury and/or property damage, the riding of e-scooters and e-skateboards is not permitted within the park boundaries.

FIRES: No open or solid fuel fires are to be lit at any time, including charcoal BBQ's

GENERATORS: The use of generators is not permitted.

GREY WATER: The majority of our sites lack greywater drainage infrastructure, meaning water is discharged directly to the surrounding ground surface.

INTERNET: 5GB of complimentary wifi is available per day available only at the BBQ Hut for all guests. Wifi Name: Shellharbour Holiday Park

LAUNDRY: The Laundry facility is located on northern side of the amenities block for guest use. Please see the map provided for location. Clotheslines are available outside the laundry facilities. You can find these on the map. Please note pet bedding is not permitted to be washed in the machines.

LINEN: All cabins receive a mid-stay service for booking of 7 nights or longer. If you need additional linen or fresh towels, please come see us at reception.

NOISE: Please be respectful of other guests in the park by minimising noise from TVs, music and social gatherings between the hours of 10pm and 8 am.

PARKING: One car park is allocated per reservation. Should you need additional parking, please give us a call at reception prior to your arrival to check availability.

PETS: must be on a lead and under control at all times. They may not be left unattended. Pets are not permitted in any common areas, including camp kitchen and amenities.

RUBBISH: All areas are to be kept clean and tidy. Rubbish needs to be tied in a plastic bag before disposing of it in the bins provided to keep the flies and ants at bay.

SECURITY: While Management do their best to ensure a safe and secure environment, we do recommend that you secure your valuable items for extra peace of mind

SMOKING: Please note that smoking is not permitted in any accommodation, amenities or common areas.

SPEED LIMITS: All roads in the park are shared by pedestrians and vehicles. For this reason, speed limits are restricted to 5km/per hour (walking pace) at all times.

TOUR DESK: Our reception staff are happy to assist with any queries you may have about activities available in the area. Come have a chat with us.

VISITORS: Please be aware that any visitors that you invite to the park must adhere to the properties condition of entry and will be the responsibility of the guest. Visitors may leave their car in the visitor car park and must be offsite by 10pm. Visitors are not permitted to bring their own pets.

WILDLIFE: Please don't feed any of the wildlife as human food can be detrimental to their health and behaviour.
