#### The experience

Witness magnificent turtles nesting and hatching just metres from your accommodation. Nightly tours run from the Mon Repos Turtle Centre adjacent to Turtle Sands during the turtle season (November to March).

But it's not all about the tutrles, at Turtle Sands you'll discover a year round destination where pristine beaches and unique wildlife combine to deliver adventure, discovery and relaxation, no matter the season.

#### The property

Nestled just behind the dunes overlooking the beach, the newly-built property exudes coastal charm and is surrounded by landscaped gardens and a lush green belt with a network of private tracks connecting guests to modern facilities which include a large pool area and various social spaces and amenities.



#### Accommodation

Designed with a way for everyone to stay, choose from spacious villas and glamping to beachfront caravan and campsites nestled behind the dunes. Our contemporary accommodation is designed to help you enjoy nature in an immersive but sensitive way.

#### **Commitment to conservation**

Turtle Sands is located beside a globally significant turtle nesting ground, visited by endangered and at-risk species.

We're privileged to act as caretakers of this land, as are our guests who stay on the site. We take our responsibility to help care, protect and conserve these species and their habitat very seriously and ask that our guests do too.

Guests staying in the turtle nesting season between October and April are asked to agree to our Turtle Protection Promise.

- External lighting is prohibited between 7.30pm and 6am – all curtains must be closed, external lights switched off, and only parking lights allowed for cars
- Check ins after 7.30pm won't be accepted
- No beach access from 6pm-6am
- No pets are allowed at any time (excluding assistance animals)
