With flexible streaming options available on the OneFootball platform, which includes mobile, desktop, and connected TV applications, OneFootball ensures that Serie A's thrilling action is easily accessible. Within the *Home of Serie A* all matches will be made available throughout the season: Eight games per match round will be accessible exclusively on OneFootball platform, and the remaining two will be co-exclusive.

Fans in the UK and Ireland can now start following the *Home of Serie A* channel on OneFootball. During the second and third rounds, OneFootball will offer eight exclusive matches on *Home of Serie A* channel for free. The two non-exclusive matches will be available on an accessible pay-per-view basis for £ 4.99 per match.
