Submission of documents for 2022-2023

Dear students and PhD students,

Based on the bilateral agreements concluded by the Trakia University and its main units under the “Erasmus+” program, a procedure for application and selection of students, doctoral students and medical specialists for participation in the mobility in the academic year 2022-2023 begins.

Full-time and part-time students (Bachelor, Master and Doctor Degree) can apply for student mobility for the purpose of study or internship, after successfully completing the first year at the Trakia University and medical specialists at TrU.

Students must have a general success from their previous study "Good", PhD students and graduates present a copy of the diploma of higher education in the specialty.

All applicants must be fluent in the language in which the training or practice will be conducted in the host country.

More than one participation in the Erasmus + program is allowed, but the total duration of the realized and planned mobilities should not exceed 12 months within the same ECL (bachelor, master, doctor).

The list of renewed and newly concluded contracts with the host universities is published on the website of TrU-International Activity, “Erasmus+” Program at TrU (BG)

Applicants submit to the coordinators of the main units the following documents:

- Application form (according to a sample from the TrU website);
- Assurance of the average success from the study at the time of application;
- Document for proficiency in the foreign language.

Students who wish to complete an internship up to one year after successful graduation (successfully passed state exams or a diploma project) must submit the documents within the specified deadlines and be selected while they have student status.

Deadline for submission of documents is:

- *June 25, 2022* for mobility in 2022-2023 for training or practice purposes during the winter/summer semester, summer practice, whole year.

When submitting the application documents, students and doctoral students are obliged to take into account the current information on the measures for COVID-19 and the conditions of residence in the host country and the university / institution where they wish to conduct their studies or practice.

Main units carry out the selection of the candidates in strict compliance with the selection criteria set out in the Rules for management of the activities under the program in TrU. The list of ranked candidates, summarized and approved at the university level will be published on the TrU website. Candidates approved for participation in the mobility receive financial assistance (grant) for their period of study or practice to supplement their travel, subsistence, accommodation, insurance, etc.

- Monthly grants for student mobility for study purposes
- Monthly grants for student mobility for internships

Additional information about the “Erasmus+” program, the necessary documents, the conditions for participation and the amounts of the monthly grants can be obtained from the ICM department-Rectorat, room 242 or from the website of TrU / International Activity / “Erasmus+” Program in TrU.
