Our Path to Carbon Neutrality



1. Operational Efficiency

We're empowering our sites to act by identifying and implementing energy efficiency improvement projects. These include changes to processes, updating existing equipment, and implementing new, more efficient technologies.



2. Procurement of Renewable Energy

We source renewable electricity in the areas that we operate. This includes monitoring the availability and cost effectiveness of local renewable energy, to provide electricity with lower GHG emissions.

Bradken is not limiting itself to localised grid availability, but also investing in power purchase agreements (PPAs) and renewable energy certificates (RECs).



3. Plant and Equipment Upgrades

In parallel with our switch to renewable electricity, we are upgrading plant and equipment technology to replace the need for hydrocarbon fuels such as natural gas and LPG, while still maintaining the product quality and cost effectiveness. Initial projects include the electrification of our high energy use equipment such as Heat Treatment Ovens.

We recognise that our employees, customers, shareholders and communities are all part of this journey. That's why we'll keep our stakeholders up-to-date on our progress through regular reports and news updates.

We are committed to equipping our people with knowledge and actively encouraging them to identify and share improvement opportunities.
