


Carbon Policy



LCY aspires to excellent standards and continual improvement across the business, and is committed to ensuring a site-wide focus on energy efficiency.

In order to achieve this objective, LCY commits to:

- Understanding the activities that emit carbon and ensuring systems are in place through which these can be monitored
- Setting carbon reduction targets that are challenging and achievable
- Creating and delivering action plans to drive continuous improvement
- Ensuring adequate resources are in place to achieve the targets and deliver the action plans
- Assigning clear responsibilities within the organisation for carbon management and ensuring resources and training are provided where necessary
- Engaging with all employees across the business to seek participation in carbon minimisation
- Ensuring energy efficiency and carbon minimisation are considered across all aspects of the business including procurement, design, operating procedures and business development
- Communicating our carbon performance internally and to external interested parties
- Reviewing LCY's carbon footprint and performance against targets annually
- Collaborating with business partners to promote best practice in relation to carbon management
- Undertaking a review of this policy and the carbon management plan at least annually to ensure it is documented, implemented, reviewed and maintained.
