

PERFECT ROUND BETTING RULES

1.1

Bets are settled to the Racing and Wagering Western Australia ("RWWA") pari-mutual returns.

1.2

Perfect Round allows you to bet on the outcome of multiple related sporting matches which are pre-selected by RWWA ("Tipping Pool").

1.3

At minimum, the outcomes available for you to select for each match in a Tipping Pool include for the Home team to win and for the Away team to win.

1.4

The option for you to select the teams to Draw may be available.

1.5

At minimum, you must select at least one outcome for each match contained in a Tipping Pool.

1.6

You may select multiple outcomes (e.g. Home, Away and Draw) for any match contained in a Tipping Pool (i.e. multiple combinations).

1.7

The minimum bet amount, per combination, for any Tipping Pool is \$0.50 AUD.

1.8

Dividends are calculated by dividing the net prize pool by the number of winning \$0.50 combinations.

1.9

If no entry in the pool correctly selects all winning outcomes in a Tipping Pool, 80% of the net prize pool will carryover ("Jackpot") and the remaining 20% is divided amongst the entries containing the highest number of correct selections.

1.10

If the option of a "Draw" was not available in a Tipping Pool and one or more of the matches is drawn, 80% of the net prize pool will carryover ("Jackpot") and the remaining 20% is divided amongst the entries containing the highest number of correct selections.

1.11

In the event that a Jackpot is declared, the Jackpot will be allocated by RWWA to a subsequent Tipping Pool. The Jackpot amount will be displayed on the subsequent Tipping Pool.

1.12

In the event that a match(es) within a Tipping Pool is abandoned or postponed without play having commenced, all tipping entries for that match(es) will be deemed as correct.

1.13

If a match contained within a Tipping Pool is postponed after play has commenced, the pool will remain unfinalised until that match has been completed or an official result has been declared.

1.14

A Tipping Pool will close for betting coinciding with the anticipated start time of the earliest played match in the Tipping Pool ("AST").

1.15

If the commencement of the earliest played match is delayed, the Tipping Pool shall still close at the AST.

1.16

All entries are final. Entries in a Tipping Pool cannot be cancelled.

1.17

All pool and Jackpot amounts displayed on our site are for guidance only and are provided to us by RWWA.

1.18

In circumstances where bets do not reach the pool, you will have your stakes refunded and we will not be liable for any loss of winnings that would have been due had the bet reached the pool.

1.19

In order to avoid the abuse of promotions offered by us from time to time, Perfect Round may not be available in respect of bonus bets, bets placed using non-withdrawable funds or any bets placed which would qualify customers to receive a bonus bet, bonus or promotion.

1.20

Cash Out / Partial Cash Out is not available for a bet placed in conjunction with Perfect Round.

1.21

Australian Football Rules. Any extra time conducted to determine the winner of a match shall be taken into account. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.

1.22

Rugby League. Any extra time conducted to determine the winner of a match shall be taken into account. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.

1.23

Rugby Union. Any extra time conducted to determine the winner of a match shall be taken into account. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.

1.24

Basketball. Any extra time conducted to determine the winner of a match shall be taken into account. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.

1.25

Soccer. The winning outcome for each match shall be determined by the match score at the conclusion of "Normal Time". Any extra time or a penalty shoot-out shall not be taken into account. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.

1.26

Baseball. Any extra innings conducted to determine the winner of a match shall be taken into account. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match. If, for any reason, a match is amended to become a "doubleheader" fixture, all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.

1.27

Cricket. Any tie-breaker method conducted to determine the winner of a match shall be taken into account. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.

1.28

Ice Hockey. Any extra time or a shoot-out conducted to determine the winner of a match shall be taken into account. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.

1.29

Tennis. In the event of a player retirement once a match has commenced, all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.

1.30

American Football. Any extra time conducted to determine the winner of a match shall be taken into account. If a match is postponed from one day to another (host country time), all tipping entries will be deemed as correct for that match.
