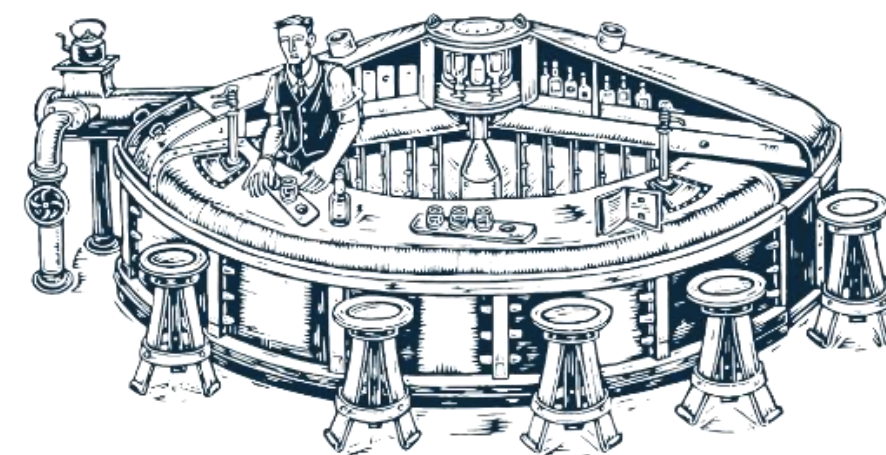

BLAIR ATHOL

An ancient Highland malt dating from 1798. Blair Athol hails from one of the most scenic regions in Scotland. Standing at the gateway to the Scottish Highlands in the foothills of the Grampian mountains. From the ancient waters of the Allt Dour burn, which flows from the slopes of Ben Vrackie, emerges Blair Athol, a mellow, deep-toned aroma boasting a strong fruit flavour with a smooth finish.

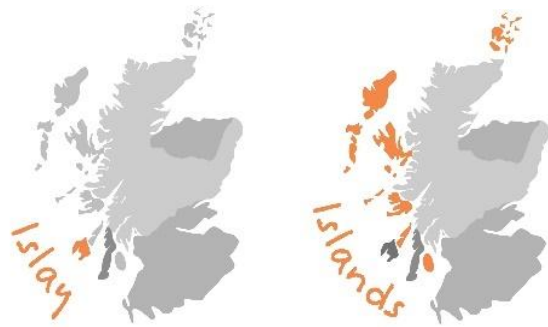

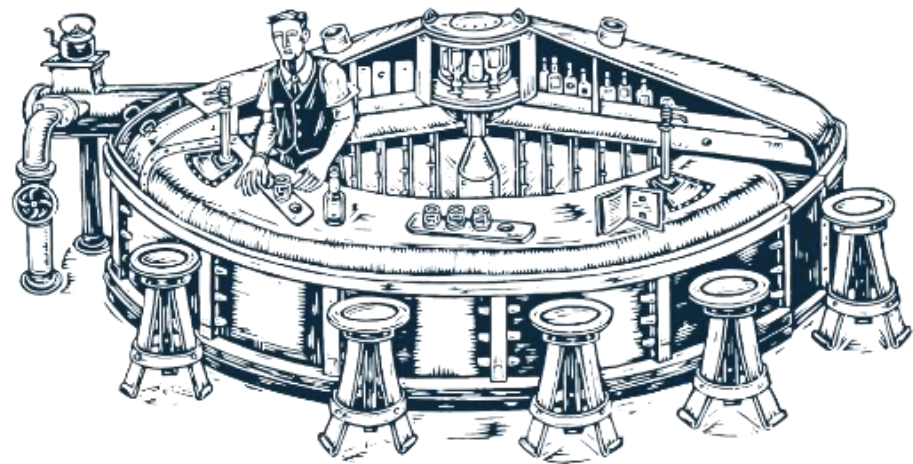

Tasting Your Whisky– The Highland Way!

Step 1: Observe

Look at the whisky in the glass. Its colour can hint at the age and the type of casks it has matured in.

Step 2: Nosing (Smelling)

Swirl the whisky in the glass to release its aromas, but don't overdo it. Bring the glass to your nose and take short, gentle sniffs, keeping your mouth slightly open to avoid the strong alcohol burn. Try to identify different scents like fruits, spice, or smoke.

Step 3: Have a Taste

Take a small sip and let the whisky coat your mouth. Notice the whisky's texture and viscosity—is it thick, creamy, or silky? Identify various flavours like sweetness, spice, or nutty notes, and see how they change as they linger. Swallow the whisky slowly and allow the warmth and flavours to develop.

Step 4: The Finish

Pay attention to the lingering taste and aroma after you swallow.

Top Tasting Tips:

- Take small sips and allow your palate to adjust to the alcohol.
- Avoid gulping or swallowing quickly; this prevents you from experiencing the full complexity.
- There are no right or wrong answers in whisky tasting; it's a personal and subjective experience.
- Some whiskies benefit from a drop or two of still, cool water, which can soften the alcohol's intensity and unlock more complex flavours.
