I've been in touch with about our next meeting, which I am very pleased will take place on 26 May.

In the process of looking through the correspondence with her, I realised that I had never replied to your message and your question, for which I sincerely applicate.

Yes, we are doing calculations on the benefits side as well, and our preliminary findings suggest that some there are benefits for at-risk and low-risk gamblers which are significant and possibly not captured by existing evidence.

Moreover, our in-house econometric models are capable of estimating the economic effects of non-intervention vs intervention, so we will use the former as another basis to estimate some of the benefits of gambling. From there, we aim to provide calculations of the effect of incremental reductions in problem gambling. Our aim is to say with some confidence not only whether and, if so, how much the gambling industry would be disadvantaged if the legislator decide to curtail certain forms of gambling but also how at-risk or low-risk gambling might grow and what the benefits to the economy would be.
