1. Toxicological information	
1.1. Sharp oral toxicity (LD50/LC50)	NO

2. Instruction for storage and assembly	
2.1. Storage conditions - dry and ventilated premises, stretched in pallets.	
2.2. Pitch boards are transported in pallets. After unloading of the pallets, the	
segments should be carefully taken out.	
3. Potential effect on health :	
- skin contact – dust and fibers may cause temporarily itching, irritation or skin	
reddening. If such irritations occur, do not rub but wash well with water and then with	
a soft soap.	
<u>- eye contact</u> – if dust falls into the eyes it may cause itching, irritation or skin	
reddening. In that case wash well with water for about 15 minutes, do not rub, and	
call a medical person.	
4. Safety Occupational rules	
Loading, unloading and mounting of mineral wool:	
\Rightarrow Use appropriate work clothes and gloves;	
\Rightarrow Use dust safety mask and glasses;	
\Rightarrow Use of hat is recommendable, especially if you work with the material	
high above your head;	
\Rightarrow If dust falls into eyes, wash well with water and call a doctor if	
necessary;	
\Rightarrow If allergic reactions occur, call a doctor.	
5. Other information:	
\square Inorganic products made of basalt mineral fibers;	
\square Open structure of fine fibers;	
\square Chemical neutral product, with no corrosive effect on metals when in contact;
