




REUNITING Pets with their People


Michael & Millie: Reunited thanks to Petco Love Lost


When Millie slipped out of her harness during a walk and was nowhere to be found, Michael uploaded her photo to Petco Love Lost.






Disaster Relief and Recovery

When disasters strike, we act quickly to provide funds, supplies and other support to save pets and aid in recovery.

In response to the devastation caused by the Southern California wildfires, we delivered critical support to impacted communities. This included on the ground staffing, grant funding, reuniting lost pets through Petco Love Lost, and evacuating shelter pets in affected areas.


