



Avalanche Floatation Device (AFD) Rental Program for the 2018-19 Season

Updated August 2018

Packs:

- For: Cariboos, Galena, Kootenay, Nomads, Revelstoke, Valemount
CMH has the Mammut Rocker Protection 3.0 AFD available for rent

Cylinders:

- CMH rents both *Mammut 2.0 cylinders* **AND** *ABS cylinders (with triggers)* for use in personal packs. Please let us know which type of cylinder you will require when reserving
- CMH does NOT refill any AFD cylinders

Costs:

- Weekly pack rental cost (includes cylinder for Mammut) is \$245 (\$35/day on shorter trips)
- Weekly cylinder (and trigger for ABS) rental cost is \$105 (\$15/day on shorter trips)
- A **non-refundable deposit** of \$105 will be added to your trip bill (payable at the lodge) for each AFD booking; no deposit is required for cylinder bookings
- Prices are subject to taxes (GST)
- CMH In-Lodge Credits may not be applied to AFD rentals

Please Note:

- For all Private programs, a complimentary AFD is provided **but must be reserved prior to the trip start**.
- Guests will be required to take the AFD off and secure the trigger device at the bottom of each run

To reserve an AFD:

- Please email your request to guestservices@cmhinc.com or call us at 1-800-661-0252; you can also contact your CMH agent or sales representative
- Guests will be required to sign a rental agreement/waiver at the lodge
- The rental cost includes an AFD orientation at the lodge before the first use
- AFD rentals are subject to availability and are on a first-come, first-served basis. We recommend booking your pack at time of final payment to help ensure that one is available

Note on PERSONAL AFDs:

- Due to size and weight restrictions with the helicopter baskets, personal AFDs will need to be approved by the Area Manager/Guide on arrival. Please note that guests are required to carry the CMH-provided probe and shovel in personal packs.
- If you plan on bringing your personal Avalanche Floatation Device, please note the following weight and size restrictions.
 - **Weight (including shovel, probe & canister):** 6lb / 2.8 kg
 - **Height:** 22" / 56cm | **Width** 12" / 30cm | **Depth:** 6" / 15cm
