As a nationally recognized commercial construction firm with a decades-long history, this company had no problem building innovative structures on university campuses, hospitals, museums and office parks across the United States. But there were issues with its payment processes.

Challenge

This firm was using separate card programs to manage purchasing and fuel—a traditional payroll card from its treasury bank and a fleet card from a specialty provider. Although the process worked, the company's controller was curious about finding more efficiency and an easier way to administer these programs.

The controller was introduced to Corpay Commercial Card (formerly Comdata) at an industry conference in 2013, and began working with a construction specialist to evaluate where Corpay could help improve payments.
