

FAKE PILLS.

REAL DANGER.

Fake prescription pills made of fentanyl, called "fentapills" have flooded social media and the streets. Don't take any medication that is not specifically prescribed to you by your doctor.

Fentapills are:

Marked to look like Oxycodone, Percocet or Xanax. Unevenly dosed, so you don't know how much fentanyl is in any one pill. Falsely advertised by dealers online and on the street.



Fentanyl is:

A synthetic opioid 50X more potent than heroin. Also found in cocaine, ecstasy and heroin. Responsible for approximately 70% of drug overdose deaths in the US.
