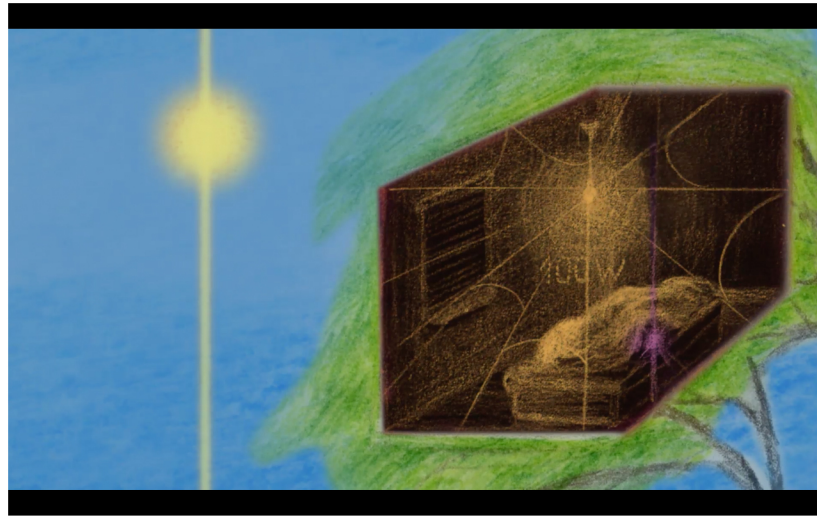

Opening: "Wojciech Bakowski: Hideout in the Corner of Level 6" at Bureau

A participating artist in the New Museum's first triennial "Younger than Jesus" in 2009 and a recipient of the prestigious Deutsche Bank Prize that same year, Wojciech Bakowski makes his solo show debut at the gallery with a selection of poetic sound, sculpture and video works. His audio piece *Hideout in the Corner of Level 6* mixes the sounds of

singing bird, ticking clocks and crackling fire to create mental images for an unfolding drama, while his new animated film *Analysis of Emotions and Vexations (II)* uses haunting sounds and sketchy drawings on fields of changing color to construct a marvelous, dreamlike realm filled with philosophical thoughts and feelings.
