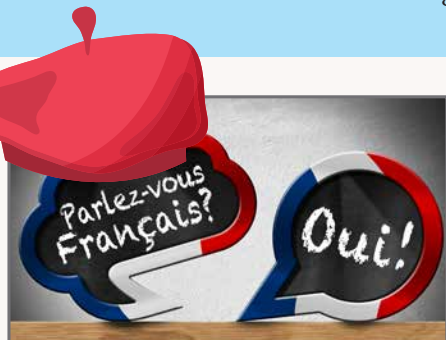


French for Seniors
