Grease is the word!

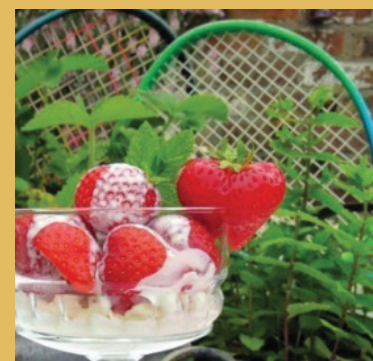


Join us on Monday 16 June at 5pm, as we celebrate 46 years since the release of the classic movie 'Grease'.
