The program is open to Institutional, Not-for-Profit, or Commercial (including multi-unit residential) facilities served directly or indirectly by Nova Scotia Power Inc. Incentives are based on a building's realized electrical energy performance verified at the meter and paid upon verification of at least a 10% reduction in electrical energy consumption.
