
UNDERSTANDING YOUR HOMEWARMING APPLICATION

Are you ready to start saving energy and money with no-cost upgrades to your home? Then it's time to complete your application for the HomeWarming program. Let's take a look at each section of your application to make things as easy as possible!






1 ELIGIBILITY

Carefully review the eligibility requirements to ensure that HomeWarming is the right program for you. If you do not meet the requirements visit **www.efficiencyns.ca/program-rebate-finder** to learn about other available programs.

2 DOCUMENTATION

All adults who live in the house as their primary residence must provide their most recent **Notice of Assessment** from the Canadian Revenue Agency. Line 236 (net income) and Line 435 (total payable) are used to evaluate the household's qualification for HomeWarming.

Your most recent **proof of homeownership** must also be included with your application. This could be a copy of your property tax assessment, property tax bill, or bill of sale.

3 HOMEOWNER NAME

First and last name of the homeowner. This must match the name identified on the supplied proof of home ownership document.

4 CIVIC ADDRESS

The address where the house is located.

This may be different from the mailing address.

Please list the house number before the street name and avoid using abbreviations.

MAILING ADDRESS


The mailing address of the person applying to HomeWarming. This only needs to be completed if the mailing address is different from the civic address.

6 SECONDARY CONTACT

If there is another person you would like to include as a secondary contact on your file, list their information here. If not, please leave blank.

DELECTRICITY ACCOUNT NUMBER

The unique electricity account number. This can be found on your electricity bill or by contacting your provider.



13 NUMBER OF RESIDENTS – ADULTS

Include all adults (over the age of 18) who live in the house as their primary residence.

9 NUMBER OF RESIDENTS - CHILDREN

Include all children (under the age of 18) who live in the house as their primary residence.

10 HOME HEATING SOURCE

If the main source of heat for the home is not listed, please explain how the house is heated.
