



Terms of Use Noordhoff

When you use a Learning Resource and/or Service, you are a User and these Terms of Use apply to you. The Terms of Use are designed to ensure that Learning Resources and/or Services are used safely. The Terms of Use form an integral part of the [General Terms and Conditions](#). Capitalised words have the meanings set out in the General Terms and Conditions.

1 Access

- 1.1 The User is only permitted to access the Learning Resources in the manner prescribed and facilitated by Noordhoff.

2 Configuration & security

- 2.1 The User is responsible for the necessary computer configuration (including hardware, network connection, bandwidth, software and associated operating systems on which the Digital Product and/or Service can function) and installation and/or configuration.
- 2.2 User is himself responsible for adequate security and virus protection of his (computer) systems.
- 2.3 It is not permitted to integrate or merge all or part of the software used to make the Service or a Learning Resource available with third-party software.

3 Normal use

- 3.1 Use is intended solely by Users for their own personal, non-commercial use or, if access was obtained through a corporate Customer with necessary rights, for that Customer's internal business purposes.
- 3.2 If User is authorised to post files or other content on Noordhoff its platform, User may only post its own materials (of which it is the copyright holder) or materials of which the necessary rights have been obtained from the copyright holder(s) so that they may be shared via the platform.
- 3.3 During use, User will:
- fulfil all obligations under the Agreement, including in also the General Terms and Conditions and these Terms of Use;
 - comply with all applicable laws and regulations, including in any case intellectual property rights, including copyright and trademark rights, and privacy law, as well as any other regulations prescribed by a government authority;
 - only post, upload and/or distribute files, data, (hyper)links and/or information if this is permitted by the (copyright) owner(s);
 - make all reasonable efforts to ensure that unauthorised access to or use of the Learning Resources, Services or User's Account is prevented;
 - keep the password and other login details confidential;
 - monitor activities on the Account so that unauthorised use is quickly detected;
 - immediately contact Noordhoff upon suspicion of illegal or unauthorised activity on the Account, loss, theft or unauthorised disclosure of login details or a breach of security of the Account or the Service; and
 - always comply with the applicable terms and conditions of Third Parties if applicable.
- 3.4 If a token, access code or other digital delivery method is used, it is only issued once, is only valid for a certain period of time and must only be used by the person(s) authorised to do so under the Agreement or agreements made with Noordhoff. The User shall treat the token, access code or other digital delivery method as strictly personal and confidential.

- 3.5 The User is not permitted to make any token, access code or other digital delivery method publicly accessible or otherwise enable unauthorised access by other persons, unless expressly permitted in writing by Noordhoff.

4 Unauthorised use

- 4.1 A Digital Product and/or Digital Service may not be edited, reproduced, disclosed, lent, rented, sold, made available to others by User and User may not use the Licence in any way other than as permitted.
- 4.2 It is forbidden to:
- act unlawfully, such as acts contrary to law, morality and/or public order;
 - commit acts that harm or threaten to harm children and/or minors in any form;
 - share inappropriate content or otherwise undesirable materials, including nudity, bestiality, pornography, offensive language, violence or criminal activity;
 - engage in fraudulent, false or deceptive activities, including asking for money under pretences, impersonating another person and manipulating services and/or products of Noordhoff or third parties;
 - circumvent access restriction measures or perform other actions that (may) affect availability, including posting malware, computer viruses or other malicious computer code, de-compiling (unless permitted by law), manipulating, bypassing, interfering with or removing data, content, software or security measures, removing any indication of Terms of Use, privacy, copyright, trademarks, trade names or other rights of (intellectual) property;
 - infringe the rights of others, e.g. intellectual property rights (including uploading, sharing, (commercially) reusing, pointing or adapting a copyrighted work without permission) and privacy rights;
 - to give a third-party permission or the opportunity to use products and/or services, unless authorised in writing by Noordhoff;
 - offer or provide assistance to others to breach the Terms of Use.

5 Enforcement

- 5.1 If the User fails to comply with the obligations under the Terms of Use or the General Terms and Conditions, Noordhoff is entitled to suspend or deny access to the Service and/or the Learning Resources or take other measures set out in the General Terms and Conditions. Noordhoff may also do so if there is a suspicion that there is a risk of damage to other users, customers, third parties or that a risk to our Services and/or Learning Resources has arisen or will arise due to the use of User.
- 5.2 Noordhoff may, during and after the Agreement has ended, investigate or arrange for the User to investigate whether the Learning Resource and/or the Service has been used in accordance with the Agreement and the Terms of Use.
