HOW DOES THE '25-'26 BUDGET COMPARE TO LAST YEAR'S BUDGET?

HOW WILL WE END THE '24-'25 FISCAL YEAR?

We are projected to end the 2024–2025 fiscal year (ending June 30, 2025) with a \$500,000 deficit. This deficit will be covered by limited cash reserves.

IF WE ARE ENDING OUR '24-'25 FISCAL YEAR WITH A DEFICIT, WHY IS OUR '25-'26 BUDGET INCREASING SLIGHTLY?

While we are projecting a deficit for the '24-'25 budget, our Business Advisory Team feels confident that the resources to cover the newly approved budget exist within our body if we clarify our needs with our members and God prompts their release. We believe this is an opportunity to invite you, our members, to help meet this need. We ask that every member seek God's leading about contributing financially to Watermark's mission. We will continue monitoring giving and spending closely in the new fiscal year, and we will adjust ministry activity as needed if the deficit continues or increases.

IF GOD INCREASED GIVING AMONG OUR MEMBERS, WHAT WOULD WATERMARK FOCUS ON?

If God released more funds from our body, the elders would use those funds to accelerate initiatives in church planting, international missions, and sending. Increased giving would also allow us to move more nimbly as the Holy Spirit continues to lead us to further implement Watermark's vision and 10 markers.
