## **POSITION RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- 1. Shepherding Community Groups
  - a. Coordinate and be primary owner for direction and vision of college women's community groups. Work heavily with College Director to stay on same page.
  - b. Communicate to College Director about specific needs for the female side of the ministry (financial, relational, ministry related)
  - c. Oversee all female college community groups and making proactive touchpoints through:
    - Yearly assessments
    - Monthly shepherd check-in
    - Bi-weekly director updates
  - d. Be available at any time for pastoral care situations involving students or shepherd
  - e. Recruit and disciple shepherds (this includes asking those not fit to step down)
- Student Lead Team
  - a. Disciple Lead Team females (college student leaders) alongside College Men's Coordinator
  - b. Plan and lead lead team meetings, retreats, etc. with College Men's Coordinator
- 3. Essential Team Member/Ministry Owner
  - a. Provide support as asked for all college events (The Nine, Retreats/Events, Campus Engagement Initiatives)
  - b. Shepherd/disciple the female participants of Watermark Institute
  - c. Participate in all required activities for Watermark Staff (expense reporting, pastor on call, Staff Prayer, Christmas Eve, AWAKEN, CLC, Easter, etc.)
