 - c. Lead, encourage, equip, and empower the RE:GENERATION for Students directional team
 - d. Coordinate the weekly program and teach at RE:GENERATION for Students
 - e. Communicate weekly reminders via email to RE:GENERATION for Students participants
 - f. Work with Watermark Resources to distribute content and resources to other churches

 - c. Mission of Hope

- 4. Availability (cell phone) after regular work hours to fulfill role duties and requirements. Watermark will reimburse a portion of cell phone expenses
- 5. Relationally engage and share work experience with participants in the Watermark Institute
- 6. Participate in general Watermark staff required activities (expense reporting, pastor on call, meetings, retreats, Christmas Eve, Easter, other "all hands on deck" events, etc.)
